


A WORD FROM YOUR PASTOR...

On this 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time we pick up the story with Jesus calling the first of His disciples. From their perspective they call into it. They witness His words and powers and

drop their nets. But Jesus knew what He was doing and who He was calling. The Gospel account today from Luke combines a few evens that we hear extended in other Gospels. Jesus teaches from the boat just off shore, He

instructs the fishermen to put out their nets for a great catch and He calls disciples. All of the experience off shore was initiated to call forth disciples, fishermen with eyes on a different catch of the day.



Like those first disciples we too feel hesitant and unworthy for the task but Jesus says not to be afraid. The first reading tells us about Isaiah vision and His hesitation. He then has a vision of an angel taking a hot coal from the sanctuary to touch his lips. Isaiah responds: "Here I am Lord, send me." Perhaps we too need moments of inspiration and maybe they are happening but we aren't tuned in. God calls us into action and new life but we need to listen. Listening takes time and today we might even have to put it on our schedules.

Enjoy these Ordinary days! A later Easter (April 20) brings a late Lent (March 5). Embrace these days before our annual retreat leading to the journey to joy.




THE CALL OF SIMON THE FISHERMAN

Luke 5:1-11

While the crowd was pressing in on Jesus and listening to the word of God, he was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret. He saw two boats there alongside the lake; the fishermen had disembarked and were washing their nets. Getting into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, he asked him to put out a short distance from the shore. Then he sat down and taught the crowds from the boat. After he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." Simon said in reply, "Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish and their nets were tearing. They signaled to their partners in the other boat to come to help them. They came and filled both boats so that they were in danger of sinking. When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at the knees of Jesus and said, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." For astonishment at the catch of fish they had made seized him and all those with him, and likewise James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners of Simon. Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching men." When they brought their boats to the shore, they left everything and **followed** him.
