

Just a reminder our Christmas event will be on December 19th.




### THE CLEANSING OF TEN LEPERS Luke 17:11-19

As he continued his journey to Jerusalem, he traveled through Samaria and Galilee. As he was **entering** a village, ten **lepers** met [him]. They stood at a distance from him and raised their voice, saying, "Jesus, Master! Have pity on us!" And when he saw them, he said, "Go show yourselves to the **priests**." As they were going they were cleansed. And one of them, realizing he had been healed, returned, glorifying God in a loud voice; and he fell at the feet of Jesus and thanked him.
