



A WORD FROM YOUR PASTOR...

Today, November 2 is the Commemoration of All Souls Day. We remember our loved ones who have died. We especially remember those that we lost this year and celebrated here. We will have a special Mass of Remembrance on

Tuesday at 6:30pm. At that Mass the names of those whose

funerals we celebrated here or Fr Carroll or one of our deacons presided at will be proclaimed. As mentioned in last week's bulletin, you may add names to the book of the dead in the mediation hall or place someone's picture on the remembrance table but we will keep the proclamation of names to those in our funeral record.



SETON'S CHILDREN'S CHRISTMAS CHOIR ~ Registration for the Children's Christmas Choir is open! We have a University student who is a music major volunteer to help with the training and coordination. Look for registration forms in the *Gathering Space*. At present, we believe that we can have 6

rehearsals, three in November and 3 in December on Thursday evenings at 6:30 pm practicing for 60 - 90 minutes on average. Children will sing at the 4 pm mass on Christmas Eve.




