From the Paster

Dear Friends in Christ,

The month of November brings to mind those who have passed from this life to the next. During this month the church encourages us to pray for the souls in purgatory, which the

catechism calls the "final purification of the elect." You will notice our readings, which come now at the end of our liturgical year, lead us to ponder the four last things: death, judgment, heaven and hell.

Immediately upon our death each of us will undergo our particular judgment. We will be judged on the love we have poured out (or held back) for others in our lives. In that moment the truth of our lives will be revealed to us. We will see things as they really are. We will go to heaven or hell. Purgatory is the place where souls destined for heaven will go who need final purification.

To have a favorable judgment we must die in the state of grace, having persevered in faith, hope and love. The best way to prepare for judgment is making a good confession each month. In that routine of confession we anticipate our judgment. We experience that the judge is both just and merciful.

Thankfully, God does not treat us according to our sins, he never tires of forgiving us. Yet we know that our moral actions have eternal consequences. We don't simply drift from this life into heaven. Jesus took upon himself my sins, but he waits for me to hand them over to him by an act of repentance.






