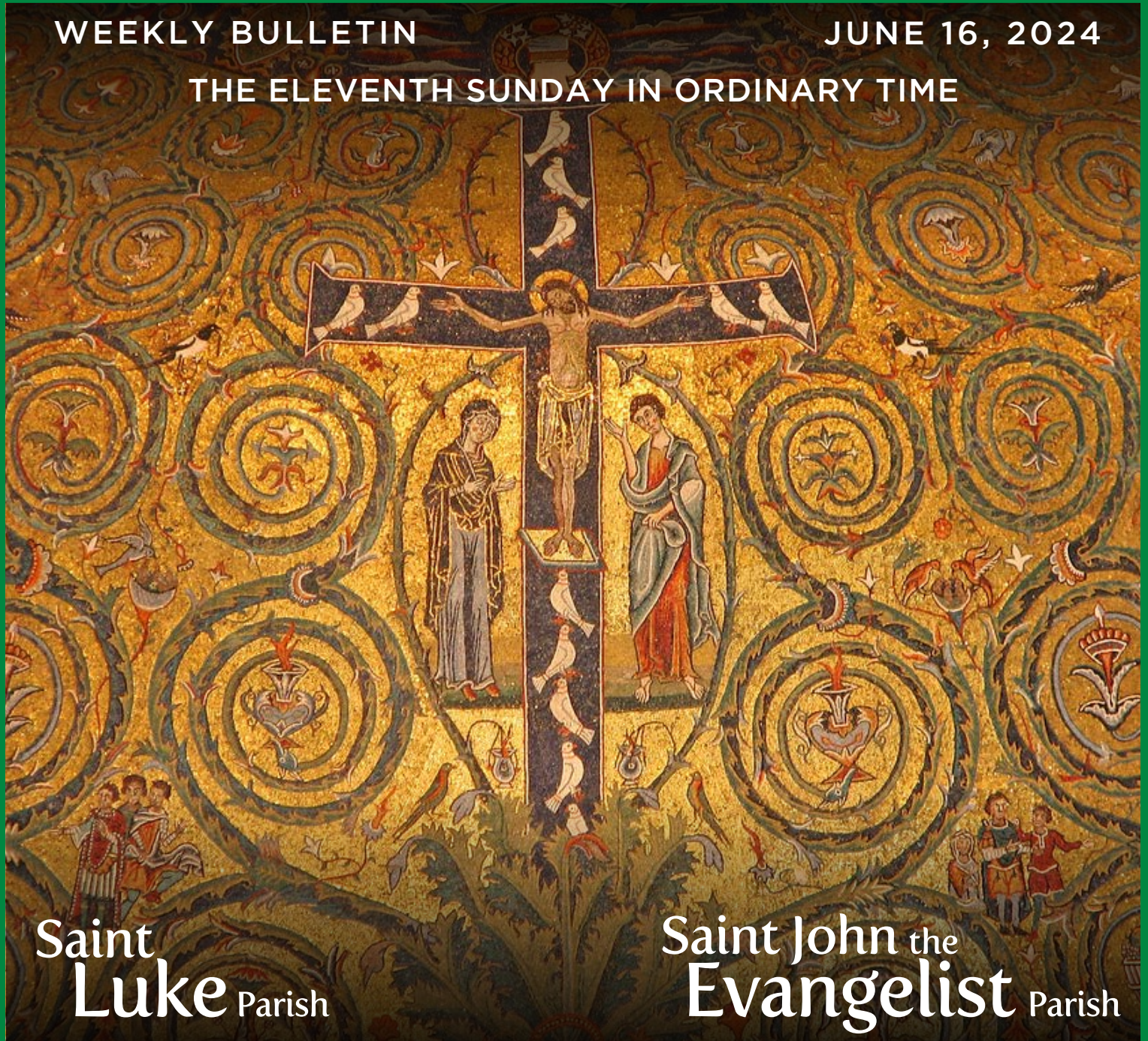

Dear Friends in Christ,

Summer is in full swing! These long days of light should make us think of heaven, where, as we read in the final chapter of the Bible:

**"Night will be no more, nor will they need light from lamp or sun, for the Lord God shall give them light, and they shall reign forever and ever (Rev. 22:5)."**

Do we miss out on earthly joys if we live for heaven? That is a common idea but it is mistaken. Jesus promises a hundredfold return even in this life for our sacrifices:

We will be serving donuts this weekend and if you wish to donate toward **Biking For Babies**, there will be a basket to do so. Jimmy Becker and Mike Schaefer took their bikes to Southern Illinois University Carbondale, in March 2009, with the goal to bicycle 600 miles in order to fundraise and raise awareness for the women and family focused efforts taking place at pregnancy resource centers. They raised \$14,000 for a local pregnancy resource center. In 2010 they began a national journey and the teams rode from New Orleans, LA to Champaign, IL, riding over 1,000 miles in 8 days. In the last 14 years they have raised money to help support 127 pregnancy centers, donated \$1.61 million dollars to life-affirming work, and pedaled 31,000 miles across the nation. They continue to make a difference and list this Bible passage on their website: **1 Corinthians 16:13**—"Be alert, steadfast in faith, be courageous, be strong, and let all that you do, be done in love." May God continue to bless their work!

**St. John Sound System:** We are still seeking donations for the Sound System at St. John. We have **\$10,900** raised (some pledged and some paid). The total cost is \$47,000. As a further "boost" to our fundraising effort a new sound system would allow us to incorporate a T-Loop system at no further cost to us. The T-Loop systems connect automatically with most hearing aids, increasing the volume of whatever music, reading or preaching that is coming through the sound system. Our current system, being 34 years old, does not have the ability to connect to a T-Loop.

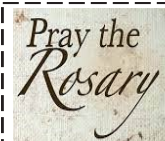
