Dear Friends in Christ,

This week we begin our 5-week journey through the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John. This chapter, known as the "bread of life discourse," is the clear teaching that the Eucharist is the Body, Blood, Soul and

Divinity of Jesus. The teaching is so clear and powerful that at the end of the chapter the Apostles complain to Jesus: "This is a difficult teaching, who can accept it?" ...and just a few verses later: "From that time on many of His disciples turned back and no longer walked with Him."

To accept that Jesus is truly present in the consecrated bread and wine we must have a childlike faith. It is the creative power of God, the same power that created the universe, which transforms those earthly elements into his living flesh.

We should ask the Lord very often to increase our Eucharistic faith. I know that when I spend time in silence before the Blessed Sacrament I grow in this faith. I sense (with my heart, not my external senses) that he is truly there!

"I throw myself at the foot of the Tabernacle like a dog at the foot of his Master. When you awake in the night, transport yourself quickly in spirit before the Tabernacle, saying: 'Behold, my God, I come to adore You, to praise, thank, and love you, and to keep you company with all the Angels.' All the good works in the world are not equal to the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass because they are the works of men; but the Mass is the work of God. Martyrdom is nothing in comparison for it is but the sacrifice of man to God; but the Mass is the sacrifice of God for man. If we knew the value of the Holy Mass, we would die of joy. Go, then, to Communion. My children, go to Jesus with love and confidence. Go, to live by Him in order to live for Him. Do not say that you have too much to do." – St. Jean Vianney
