# THE NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME AUGUST 11, 2024



Dear Friends in Christ,

On August 15th the Church celebrates the joyful solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, body and soul, into heaven. Because Mary was conceived without

sin, she did not experience any corruption or suffering in her body upon death. Her flesh, from which Jesus took his flesh, was perfect, and passed directly from this world into heaven. We do not really speak of Mary's death, but rather her "dormition" and her "assumption" into heaven.

In time of need I find myself turning to Our Blessed Mother's powerful intercession. Mary is a good mother who knows best what we need. At the wedding feast at Cana she was the only one to notice: "they have no wine." Today she notices when we are running low on the "wine" of God's joy. She, seeing our spiritual poverty, turns to God (she is closer to God than anyone else) and says once again, "they have no wine."

In May of 2010 Pope Benedict XVI visited the shrine dedicated to Mary in Fatima, Portugal. Upon his visit he consecrated all priests to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Here are a few of his beautiful words, addressed directly to Mary:

"Repeat to the Lord your efficacious word: "They have no wine" (Jn 2:3), so that the Father and the Son will send upon us a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit...

> Our Mother for all time, do not tire of "visiting us", consoling us, sustaining us. Come to our aid and deliver us from every danger that threatens us."

Because Mary is close to God she is close to each one of us. She does hear our prayers (God grants her this ability) and presents our needs to God. Pope Benedict XVI explains her intercession with these beautiful words:

"Advocate and Mediatrix of grace, you who are fully immersed in the one universal mediation of Christ, invoke upon us, from God, a heart completely renewed that loves God with all its strength and serves mankind as you did."

I pray that this month, by staying close to Mary, you will experience a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit in your lives! in prayer,


