

His Excellency Archbishop Barwa is the archbishop of Cuttack-Bhubaneswar, my home diocese. He was my liturgy professor (2000-2005) while I was still a seminarian for the archdiocese of Cuttack-Bhubaneswar, Orissa. Archbishop Barwa was born on June 1, 1955. He was ordained a priest in 1985. Archbishop Barwa was consecrated coadjutor bishop of Rourkela on April 19, 2006. Hopeful of quelling the violence against Christians in the Indian state of Orissa, Pope

Benedict XVI appointed him archbishop of Cuttack-Bhubaneswar on February 11, 2011. Archbishop Barwa is on his annual mission appeal and pastoral visit to his communities of Society of Divine Word in the USA. He is gracious to pay a visit to me. It will be great meeting him, me as a priest of the diocese of Madison after almost 19 years. Archbishop Barwa will celebrate Holy Eucharist on Saturday, August 31st, at 5:30 PM at St. John the Evangelist, Spring Green and Sunday, September 1st at 10:00 AM at St. Luke, Plain. You all are welcome to listen to his amazing faith-witness of the 35 martyrs from my native place, cause by the Hindu fundamentalist.

Creation Care Corner

Taking action to protect God's great gift to us

Celebrate the Season of Creation ~ The Season of Creation is a month-long prayerful observance that calls upon Catholics to pray and care for God's Creation. It starts September 1st and ends October 4th. It's a time to reflect on our relationship with the environment, how we live, and how our lifestyles impact the natural world, humans and other

creatures inhabiting it. This "time for creation" offers, in the words of Pope Francis, "individual believers and communities a fitting opportunity to reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care, and to implore his help for the protection of creation...". The US Conference of Catholic Bishops reminds us that "we show our respect for the Creator by our stewardship of Creation". Pope Francis urges us to recognize our connectedness with the natural world saying, "Nature cannot be regarded as something separate from ourselves or as a mere setting in which we live. We are part of nature, included in it and thus in constant interaction with it." (LS 139). Advocating for Creation Care helps safeguard the inheritance the Creator has given us, an inheritance essential to our well-being. Pope Benedict XVI told us that protecting this inheritance is a way of fulfilling our role as stewards of Creation.


