

Dear Friends in Christ,

Parter September 8th is one of my favorite days of the year ~ the Birthday of Mary. Saints Joachim & Anne longed

to have a child; and, in their old age, God granted them the most perfect of children in the Blessed Virgin Mary. Mary was chosen by God not simply to be the Mother of God, but also to be a close follower of her Son, all the way to the Cross.

Mary received everything from God with a humble and daring heart. As a teenager she was not afraid to ask the Angel Gabriel a clarifying question (about the child she was to conceive): "How can this be since I have no relations with a man?" This was a daring question! Here we see Mary is the first Christian philosopher. She is not doubting God's plan, but seeking to know more clearly her mission.






