Dear Friends in Christ,

The season of Advent brings a new, fresh beginning to our minds and hearts. It is a season of looking for Christ, of seeking him who comes, as the saying goes, in "history, mystery and glory." It is

important this time of year that we take time to pray. There are so many good things to do that it would be very easy to skimp on prayer--but prayer must always come first. Jesus is clear in today's Gospel that prayer is how we prepare for his coming in glory--will the Lord find us vigilant when he comes?

The catechism dedicates the entire fourth (and final) section to the topic of prayer. A good way to begin to pray would be to (prayerfully) read through that last section. Catechisms are going for \$7.00 from Amazon--that would be a great investment if you don't have one handy!

Although we can pray anywhere, the best place to pray is in the church before the tabernacle. Jesus is there waiting for us in silence. He wishes to speak to us a word of comfort or challenge. Let us be generous this Advent in silent prayer-waiting with Mary for the coming of the Lord at Christmas.

Here are a few of my favorite paragraphs from the Catechism on Prayer:

2725 Prayer is both a gift of grace and a determined response on our part. It always presupposes effort. The great figures of prayer of the Old Covenant before Christ, as well as the Mother of God, the saints, and he himself, all teach us this: prayer is a battle. Against whom? Against ourselves and against the wiles of the tempter who does all he can to turn man away from prayer, away from union with God. We pray as we live, because we live as we pray. If we do not want to act habitually according to the Spirit of Christ, neither can we pray habitually in his name. The "spiritual battle" of the Christian's new life is inseparable from the battle of prayer.

2744 *Prayer is a vital necessity.* Proof from the contrary is no less convincing: if we do not allow the Spirit to lead us, we fall back into the slavery of sin. How can the Holy Spirit be our life if our heart is far from him?

- Nothing is equal to prayer; for what is impossible it makes possible, what is difficult, easy. ... For it is impossible, utterly impossible, for the man who prays eagerly and invokes God ceaselessly ever to sin.
- Those who pray are certainly saved; those who do not pray are certainly damned. St. Alphonsus Ligouri



Taking action to protect God's great gift to us

Gratitude, Generosity and Stewardship

In the Encyclical, Laudato Si': On Care for Our Common Home, Pope Francis encourages us to imitate God's generosity, calling for an attitude of "...gratitude and gratuitousness, a recognition that the world is God's living gift, and that we care called quietly to imitate his generosity in self-sacrifice and good works."

Pope Francis further explains, "One expression of this attitude is when we stop and give thanks to God before and after meals. I ask all believers to return to this beautiful and meaningful custom. That moment of blessing, however brief, reminds us of our dependence on God for life; it strengthens our feeling of gratitude for the gifts of creation; it acknowledges those who by their labours provide us with these goods; and it reaffirms our solidarity with those in greatest need." (LS 222, 227). We show our respect and gratitude to the Creator by our stewardship and recognition of his bountiful creation as a precious gift requiring our care! Happy Thanksgiving Week!
