Other Notes:

We have added a penance service to our Advent Calendar, We will have one outside priest coming to St. John's on Saturday, December 21st. The service will begin at 10 AM with a short reading from Scripture and examination of conscience. Confessions will be heard from 10 a.m.-11 a.m. (Confessions will also be heard from 1:00 p.m.-4:00 p.m. on Dec. 19th at St. Luke and Dec. 20th at St. John.)

Important update on upcoming St. John's Church closure:

Sunday January 5th will be the last mass in St. John's church for roughly 6-7 weeks for our renovation project. Please say a prayer that all goes well!

I have decided to move the 8:30 AM Sunday Mass to St. John the Baptist Mill Creek during the closure. We have a sizable group of parishioners who live near Arena - this mass will be more convenient for them to attend. The nearest mass within our pastorate for them would have been 17 miles. During the closure of St. Luke Church we had a church 7 miles north (Loreto) and 7 miles south (SJE) that were open for parishioners who lived in Plain. We will continue to have daily mass on Wednesday and Friday (school mass) at St. John's in the parish hall at 8:30 AM. Fr. Kumud will have Prink after daily mass on Wednesdays.

St. John parishioners may put their offertory envelopes in any collection basket during the closure. During the closure period there will be only one Saturday vigil mass - 4:00 PM at St. Luke.




