This past week we had our biggest high school youth group to date! Fifteen of our teenagers gathered at St. Patrick's Church on a cold Wednesday evening to listen to Molly Mahoney speak about

Other notes:

This message was sent out to our school families this past week regarding the changes taking place at River Valley schools.

Dear School Families,

At last evening's River Valley school board meeting, the district made a decision to close the Early Learning Center in Plain at the end of the 2024-2025 school year. Additionally, grade level configurations will change for the district in the next school year. You may be wondering what, if any, impact this will have on our two Catholic Schools, St. John and St. Luke. For the 2025-2026 school year, both St. John and St. Luke will be operating with the current grade levels and configurations:

~3K - 4th Grade at St. John in Spring Green ~3K - 8th Grade at St. Luke in Plain

The only change we anticipate at this time regards bussing and the start and end time of our school day. As that information is known it will be shared with school families. Bussing is always provided for any catholic school family who lives in the River Valley District. Specifically, any 5th - 8th Grade student attending St. Luke and living in the River Valley school district is provided bussing to and from Plain. The lower grades are also provided bussing, but only to the school (St. John or St. Luke) which is nearest to them.

We are blessed to have two strong Catholic schools which prepare students very well to enter the high schools and middle schools in our area, including, but not limited to, River Valley. We see many of our alumni on the local honor rolls and involved in our parishes and churches after leaving our schools. I encourage you to share with your friends that our schools are always available for tours, please just reach out to our principals. Thank you for your continued support and prayers!



YEAR SO END GIVING As we come to the end of the calendar year, December 31, THANK YOU for your contributions and your support of St. John, St. Luke and St. Patrick churches, schools and ministries! A reminder that if a donor

(parishioner) wishes to claim a contribution as a charitable deduction for income tax purposes, then the donor must relinquish control of the funds before it is technically a contribution.
