From the Parter

Dear Friends in Christ.

The baptism of the Lord concludes our Christmas season. It's time to pack up the nativity scenes and place them safely in storage until next year.

We now enter in to "ordinary time," or simply "time throughout the year." During this time, in our Sunday gospel readings, we follow Jesus throughout his public ministry, which is inaugurated by the baptism.

The baptism is the very first public revelation of the Holy Trinity. The Father's voice, the Spirit in the form of a Dove and the Son who is Jesus are all there. Our Lord goes under the water to bury our sinful nature and begin the public portion of his process of redemption. As much as I love contemplating Jesus working at home with Mary and Joseph, he wasn't sent to stay there. He was sent from God to live an intense public life culminating in his death and resurrection.

Throughout his public ministry of teaching, preaching and healing, Our Lord takes time to pray. He then launches out inspired by his prayer to "destroy the works of the devil." He complicates his life for others—for us.

In this new year, where might the Lord be calling me to complicate my life for others? Are we not tempted sometimes to hide our light under the bushel basket? Are we uncomfortable, perhaps, with being public with our faith? We may not be called to preach or teach, but we are called to "let our light shine before others."






