Dear Friends in Christ,

In light of the forthcoming merger of St. Luke and St. John parishes next year—with the additional rural churches of Mill Creek, Lime Ridge and Loreto, the time has come to establish a Pastoral Council. Soon after

arriving I established the transition team to replace both pastoral councils. That group has done some great work in bringing us together as a Pastorate. Now we will be phasing out the transition team and establishing a Pastoral Council which will bring us through the actual merger and beyond. The Diocese of Madison recommends all parishes have a pastoral council although canon law would require only a finance council. I am of the school that a pastoral council is indeed useful in parish life. This description comes from the Diocese:

"The mission of the Pastoral Council is to assist the pastor in identifying and understanding important matters that affect the life of the parish, to gather the thoughts and ideas of the community, and discuss them with the pastor as together they seek the good of the parish."

To establish the council, I will take the following steps:

- 1) Collect nominations: in paper on the last two weekends of May, or by e-mail to me.
- 2) Notification: nominees can accept or decline
- 3) Meeting with Transition Team to discern who is selected.

(At our most recent transition team meeting it was decided that selection by Discernment would be simpler and easier than by ballot. It is hard to conduct a vote in the summer months when parishioners are often on the move.)

I am seeking nominations for the following spots on the Pastoral Council:

- 1) Council Chair (officer)
- 2) Vice-Chair (officer)
- 3) Secretary (officer)
- 4) Mission Representative (Chair of Go Make Disciples Team)
- 5) Buildings and Grounds Representative (Chairs the Buildings and Grounds Committee)
- 6) Schools Representative (attends both Education Commission meetings)
- 7) Parish Life Representative (fundraisers and festivals)
- 8) Human Concerns Representative (elderly, homebound, nursing home, grief support)
- 9) Parish Secretary Trustee (ex-officio member)

Please prayerfully discern if God might be asking you to join our Pastoral Council. We will meet at least six times per year, but not more than ten.

Nominations will be collected during the Masses on the last two weekends of May. You may also nominate yourself or someone else by simply sending me an e-mail.




