

Dear Friends in Christ.

This week's first reading features St. Paul on his first missionary journey. Paul, famously, took three such missionary journeys, establishing churches and leaders in each place he visited. St. Paul had a

very large and fiery personality ~ he was not afraid to mix things up and generate some commotion. He was on fire for Christ. One time St. Paul even gave a firm correction to St. Peter! It's hard to imagine the Church today without St. Paul. He is the greatest missionary in the history of the Church. St. Paul was a magnanimous, tireless soul with big dreams.

How can we spread the faith like St. Paul? How can I get my friends and family coming back to Mass? Can I do things like St. Paul did? Perhaps we can, but there is also another way to spread the faith which operates on a smaller level. In the Gospel our Lord says "This is how all will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." To be a missionary does not require us to take long, arduous travels like St. Paul. We can be missionaries by our witness of love. In fact, without love there is no possibility of doing great things for God. Loving those people closest to us is the first step in bringing souls back to Christ.

Let us dream big like St. Paul ~ but let us also love in small ways like our Lord asks us to in the Gospel. Then all will know that we are his disciples, and they will want to join us.






