From the Partor

Dear Friends in Christ.

We welcome back Fr. Kumud from his travels! This summer we also welcome Luke Voegli who will be a resident seminarian in the Pastorate this summer. Luke is studying at St. Francis de Sales seminary in Milwaukee

and has just completed his first year of studies.

This Sunday we celebrate Corpus Christi. On this day we take Jesus out into the streets in the gold monstrance to give public witness to the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. These processions are symbolic of the mission we have as apostles who are sent. We are not called by God simply to show up at mass. Christianity is a "go" religion. We must go from Mass, and, as St. John of the Cross said "where there is no love, put love." We are not churchgoers only but rather missionaries.

The final and definitive revelation of God took place by means of two missions: the Son and Spirit were sent into the world. The fruit of these missions was salvation. And for salvation to reach us most fittingly God gave us the sacramental economy-material signs which give us grace. The Eucharist we call the Most Blessed Sacrament. It is the source and summit of our faith. It is only right that, at least once a year, our love for Jesus' body and blood breaks out of the church and spills into the streets!
