Dear Friends in Christ.

"The more truly we believe, the more strongly we hope and the more ardently we desire, the more generously we will receive...in our petitions we will receive more by sighs than by speech, more by tears than by words."

These words from the Office of Readings (a set of daily prayers for priests) summarize what the Catechism calls the "battle for prayer." Very seldom does prayer come without serious effort. Those are blessed moments…but the norm for us is this: prayer takes effort and struggle.

Why go through all that struggle to pray? What good comes from it? The fruits of prayer are many but perhaps the most important is an increase in faith. Again and again, we see in the Gospels that faith is a most pleasing virtue to Jesus. He has even promised us: "If you believe you will see the Glory of God (John 11:40)." We pray to strengthen our faith – that virtue which puts us in union with Christ.

To reach prayer we must first take the time. This means putting prayer ahead of many other good things: a leisurely breakfast, a morning scroll on social media, a workout at the gym...an extra hour of sleep. These are all good things (well, maybe we could debate social media) but we should set them aside for a great thing which is prayer. A good question to ask God is: what keeps me from praying? What is my stealing my prayer time?

If you wish to read more about prayer there is no better place than the fourth part of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC). Here are a few paragraphs which give you a sense for the profound teaching contained therein:

CCC 2725 Prayer is both a gift of grace and a determined response on our part. It always presupposes effort. The great figures of prayer of the Old Covenant before Christ, as well as the Mother of God, the saints, and he himself, all teach us this: prayer is a battle. Against whom? Against ourselves and against the wiles of the tempter who does all he can to turn man away from prayer, away from union with God. We pray as we live, because we live as we pray. If we do not want to act habitually according to the Spirit of Christ, neither can we pray habitually in his name. The "spiritual battle" of the Christian's new life is inseparable from the battle of prayer.

CCC 2732 The most common yet most hidden temptation is our lack of faith. It expresses itself less by declared incredulity than by our actual preferences. When we begin to pray, a thousand labors or cares thought to be urgent vie for priority; once again, it is the moment of truth for the heart: what is its real love? Sometimes we turn to the Lord as a last resort, but do we really believe he is? Sometimes we enlist the Lord as an ally, but our heart remains presumptuous. In each case, our lack of faith reveals that we do not yet share in the disposition of a humble heart: "Apart from me, you can do nothing."




