- --Next School Year Open House night will also be picture night for kids.

Treasurer's Report: (See Treasurer's Printout Budget)

--All finances are now thru the Diocese. Motion by E. Novotny, 2nd by M. Cronce. Approved.

Old Business: Shoe Drive will be in effect thru April. Donations still welcome thru then.

- --Bowling Fundraiser success: Approx \$3,000 raised. Kwik Trip Car Wash is good idea for fundraising.
- --Emils Pizza/Riverfest Booth: Home & School fundraiser. A. Schuett and L. Wolfgram have agreed to shadow L. Rhodes and co-chair. Thank You! Watch for Sign Up Genius to help out this summer.
- --2024 H&S Officers & Classroom Representatives: J. Shea President; M. Cronce Vice President; C.Gehring Treasurer; E. Novotny Secretary. Motion J. Roberts, 2nd A. Schuett. Approved.
- --2023-2024 Classroom Representatives: We can use more parent volunteers to be a Classroom Rep. This person may attend H&S meetings and share pertinent information with the specific classroom teachers and families following the meetings, thru e-mail or newsletter or other means. Volunteers so far: 4K A. Horack; 1st grade: E. Novotny; 2nd Grade: C. Gehring; 3rd Grade J. Shea; 4th Grade A. Schuett; 5th Grade L. Cunningham; 7th Grade M. Cronce.

We need volunteers for Kindergarten, 6^{th} and 8^{th} Grades. You may contact any member of the Board to volunteer, or attend May meeting.

- --Investment Opportunities: B. Mudler proposed a 3 month CD option. S. Harms recommends that before we vote on this, President Mudler discuss with Fr. Vince once more, to make sure this is still an option for us.
- --Chrome Book Discussion: We still would need quotes for Chrome Book and Chrome Book Cart costs. Chrome Book purchases (proposed 10-15 new/year) to be added to 2023-2024 Board Budget Meeting. S. Harms proposed Technology Funding (see attached). Total amount is \$13,800. School computers last updated at an unknown time. Several computer updates are needed at both campuses. Proposal includes purchasing/installing additional cameras and a new TV for viewing security footage. Wi-fi upgrades needed. Discussion included: Asking if school admin can look into Education Foundation for funds or grants to improve technology; Asked if there is a Yearly Technology Budget for upgrades as needed; there is not a formal budget in place; Discussed splitting the costs with the school/parish. Motion for H&S funds of up to \$8100 goes towards the first 3 items on the list. 1st A. Horack 2nd J. Mudler. Approved. S. Harms asked to discuss with Fr. Vince to gain funds to cover #4 on the list as all items are needed for proper upgrade. (Next month agenda)
- --Stage Curtain: Need Quotes in order to discuss. Decided to table this for now.

- PC hard drive refresh both campuses
 - Replace traditional storage drive with Solid State drives
 - Benefit significant improvement in performance of Computer. Measurable amount of time reduced waiting for computer to boot up, shut down, launch applications and run applications. Will extend life of computer 2 to 4 years
 - Scope replace drives in 15 Computers deployed within the school
 - Cost: \$2550 (\$170 per computer)
- Surveillance Camera Display in School secretary Offices both campuses
 - Deploy a large display that has surveillance camera live streams always displayed in view of all occupants of the secretary offices at ST Henry and St Bernard Campuses
 - Benefit free up space on Secretary computer displays by eliminating need to launch camera app locally on computer. Additionally, more than one person can monitor and see the camera feeds at all time from anywhere in the offices.
 - Scope Purchase a display, a wall mount bracket, and a small form factor computer for each campus secretary office
 - Cost: \$2600 total (\$1300 per campus)
- Additional Surveillance cameras in St Henry School interior
 - Add a camera at the following locations: Cafeteria, First floor hallway, Second floor hallway, Gymnasium.
 - Benefit Improve overall school security and situational awareness for Teachers and administrators
 - Scope purchase 4 cameras, additional hard drives for video storage, and camera licenses. Deploy cameras.
 - Cost: \$2400
- Wireless Network refresh both campuses
 - Upgrade wifi network at both school campus to modern system with same equipment at both campuses.
 - O Benefit. St Bernard wifi system has been end of support for over 4 years. No firmware upgrades have been possible during that time. St Henry wifi system is also end of support. No more firmware upgrades available as of 12 months ago. St Bernard and St Henry have different wifi systems from different manufacturers. This creates complexity in maintenance and support. A new system would improve performance and reliability of connected Chromebooks, improve network security, simplify support and maintenance of Wifi networks at both campuses.
 - Scope: purchase new access points and wifi controller. Deploy the Engenius wifi solution which is also supported by Badgerland computers. A local IT support service we us within our parishes.
 - Cost: \$6250
