What is a Jubilee Year?

A Jubilee is a sacred time in the Catholic Church—a year of celebration, mercy, and renewal. It is a chance to rejoice in God's love poured out abundantly. As one of six designated Jubilee sites in the Diocese of Madison, IHM is a pilgrimage site where the faithful can receive a Jubilee indulgence-a special grace of God's mercy that brings spiritual renewal and healing.

To receive this indulgence, pilgrims are invited to prayerfully visit the shrine, receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist, pray for the Holy Father's intentions, and strive to let go of attachment to sin.

This is more than a Mass - it's a celebration of faith, community, and God's endless mercy. Come, pray, celebrate, and rejoice together as a parish family with our Bishop!
