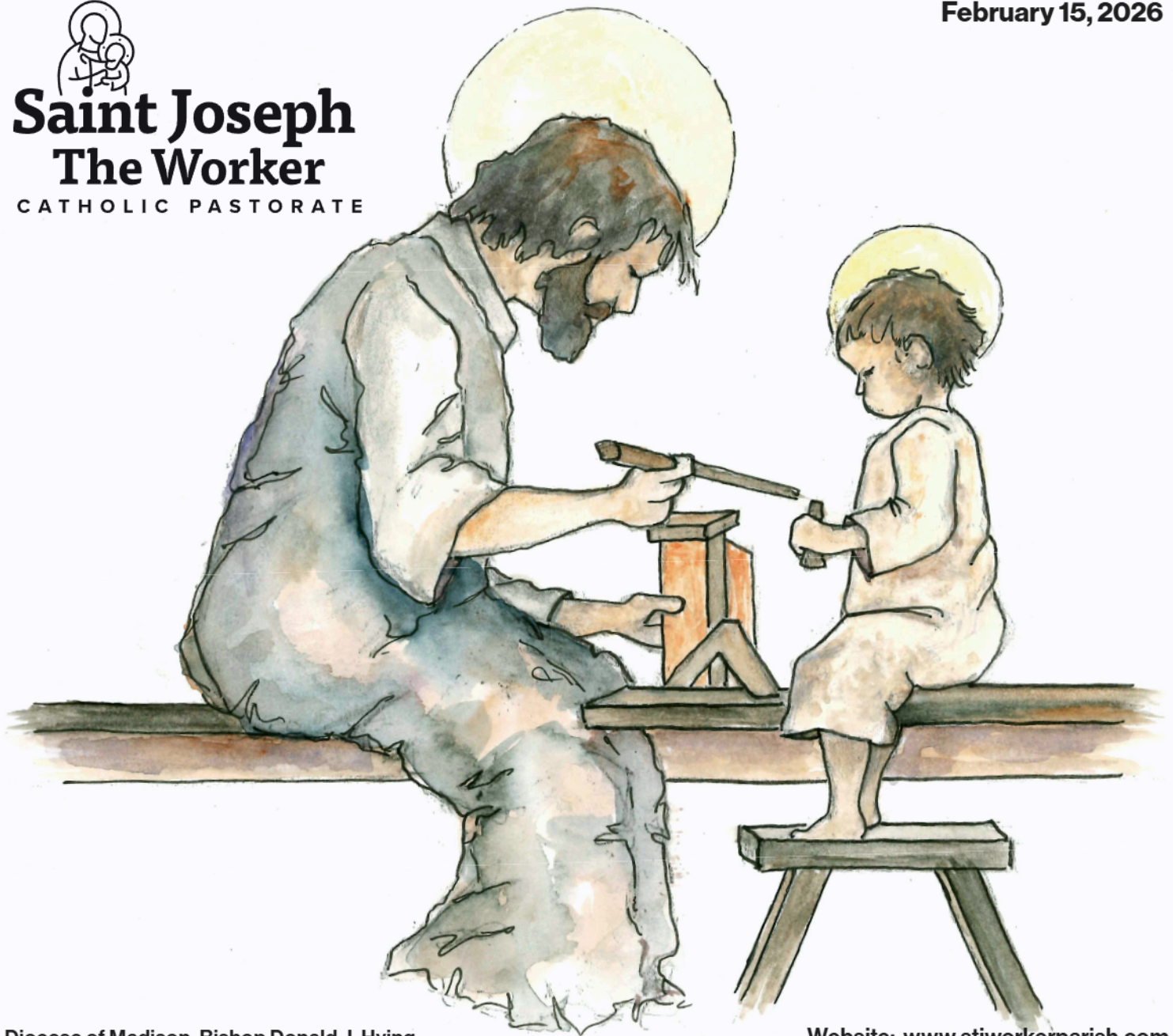

Prayerfully consider the ways you would like to grow closer to Christ this Lent. Then, commit yourself to some specific, attainable actions that you will take beginning on Ash Wednesday. The first three sections below focus on our Lenten disciplines of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. The last three sections offer additional ways you can ramp up your Lenten journey. Print out and save this page so that you can refer back to it throughout Lent.

PRAYER

During Lent, I will add the following to my daily prayer life:



Idea starters: Set list of morning prayers, Rosary, 15-minutes of silence for prayer, Liturgy of the Hours, prayers of gratitude at bedtime, Stations of the Cross

FASTING

During Lent, in addition to the fasting and abstinence prescribed by the Church, I will also give up the following:



Idea starters: Dessert, coffee, alcohol, social media, TV, radio in the car, unnecessary shopping, dining out, watching sports, complaining, eating between meals

ALMSGIVING/SERVING

During Lent, I commit to the following activities related to serving others and evangelizing:



Idea starters: Praying with your family, volunteering at church, giving to a local charity, starting a small faith group, inviting a friend to Mass, being more loving/Christ-like to a person close to you

EUCCHARISTIC DEVOTION

During Lent, I will commit to growing closer to Christ in the Eucharist by



Idea starters: Going to Eucharistic Adoration, going to daily Mass, learning more about the teachings on the Eucharist, reading a book about the Eucharist such as "The Lamb's Supper" by Scott Hahn

REPENTANCE

During Lent, I will make the following commitment to conversion and Confession:



Idea starters: Nightly examination of conscience, daily examen, commitment to attend confession on a regular schedule, prayer and reflection on the sins you struggle with the most

SPIRITUAL READING

During Lent, I will make the following spiritual reading commitment:



Idea starters: Daily Mass readings, a spiritual classic by a saint, a daily devotional, one book of the Bible, a paragraph of the Catechism a day, life of a saint each day, etc.

March Mental Health Mondays Speaker Series

All in our pastorate are invited to a 4-week speaker series that will take a deeper look at Mental Health. Each evening will take place from 6:30 - 8 PM at one of our church locations.

March 2: AN OVERVIEW OF MENTAL HEALTH MINISTRY by Laura Sokup, the Mental Health Program Coordinator for the Diocese of Madison. Laura's presentation will be held at St. Mary Church in Bloomington.

March 9: MENTAL HEALTH AND FATIH by Fr. Mick Moon, a Lancaster native, retired priest of our diocese, and licensed social worker. Fr. Mick's talk will be at St. Clement in Lancaster.

March 16: MINDSET STRATEGIES FOR BETTER MENTAL HEALTH by Deacon Larry Tranel of our diocese. Deacon Larry's presentation will be at St. Charles in Cassville.


March 23: IMPLEMENTING PARISH MENTAL HEALTH MINISTRY by Laura Sokup. She will address the vision of the diocese and introduce the pastorate's Mental Health Ministry Team. This will be held at Ss. Andrew-Thomas School in Potosi.

Each of you may know someone that deals with mental health challenges or who is a caretaker. We also know the impact that mental health has on persons, families and communities. Knowing this, we, as people of faith, are called to support one another with Christ-like understanding and compassion. Each talk in our series is stand-alone, so if you can't make one, please come to those that you can. There will be time for discussion, questions, and feedback. The cost is free. 
