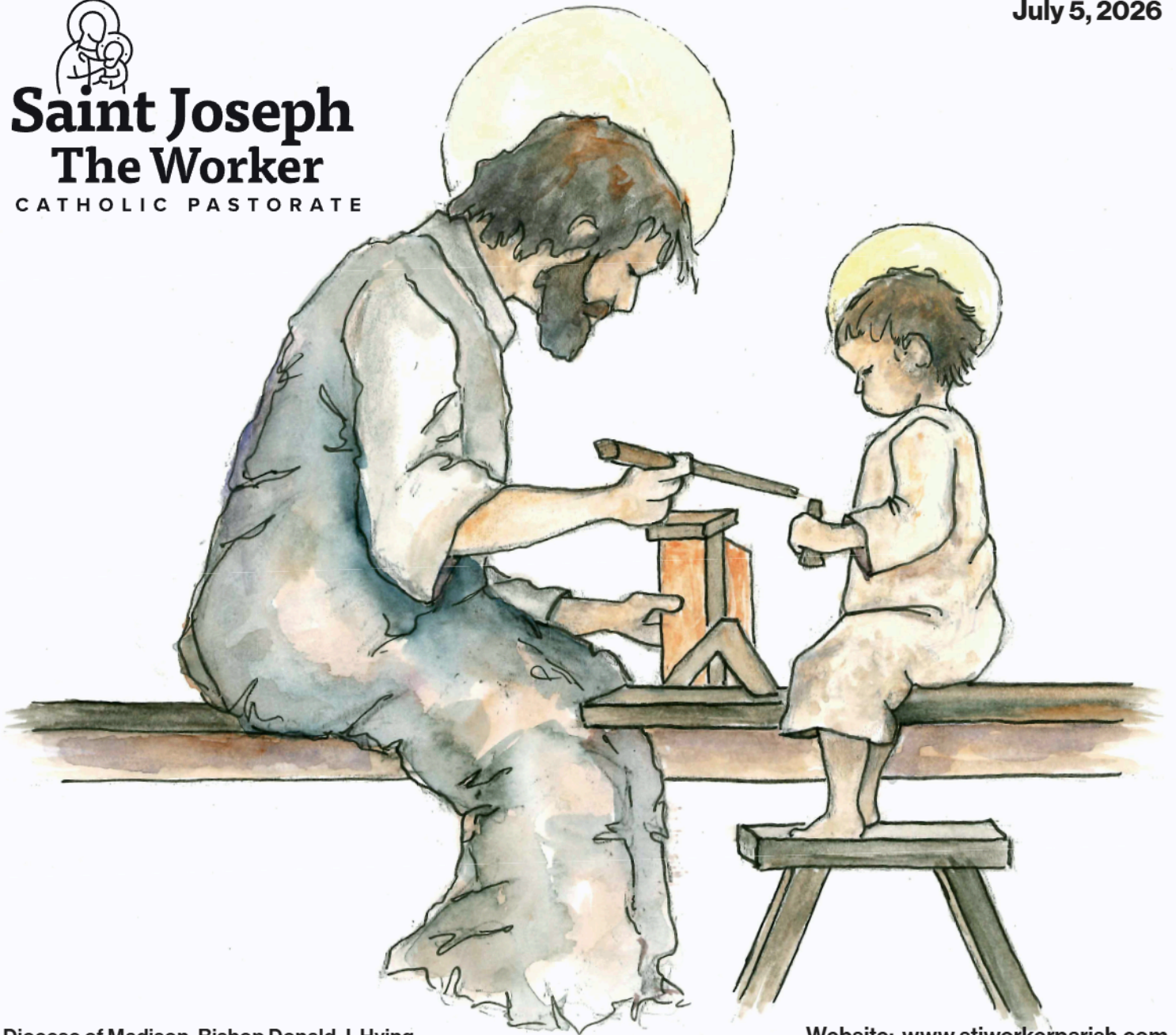


ST. MARY'S GOLF OUTING

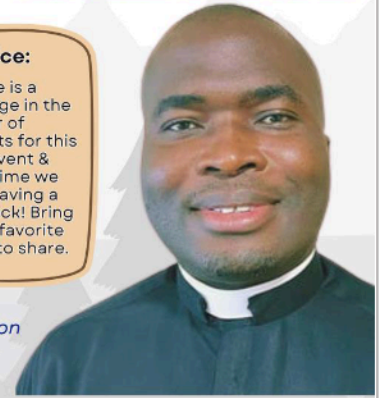
