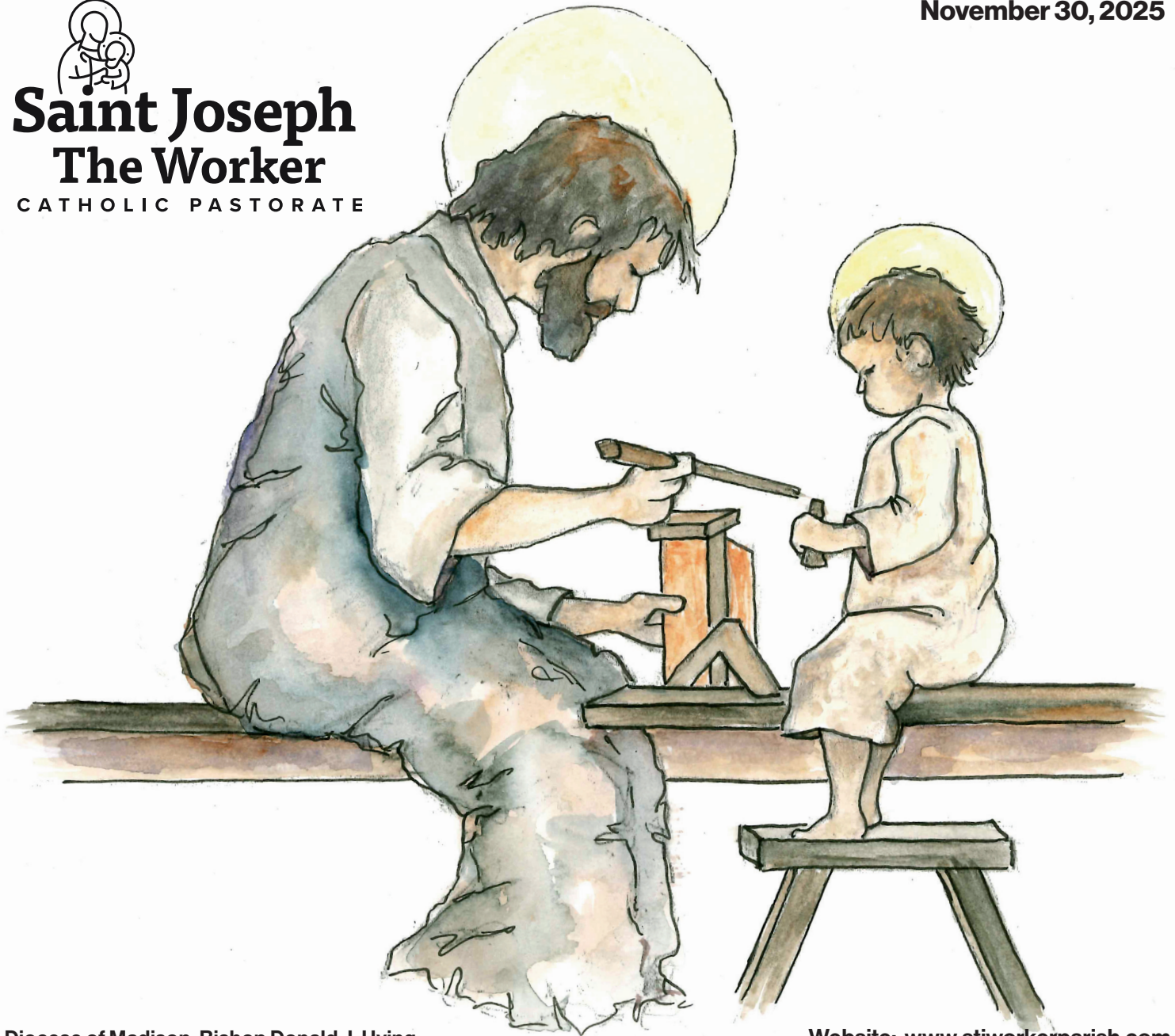

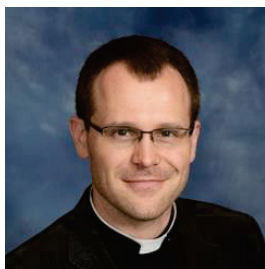

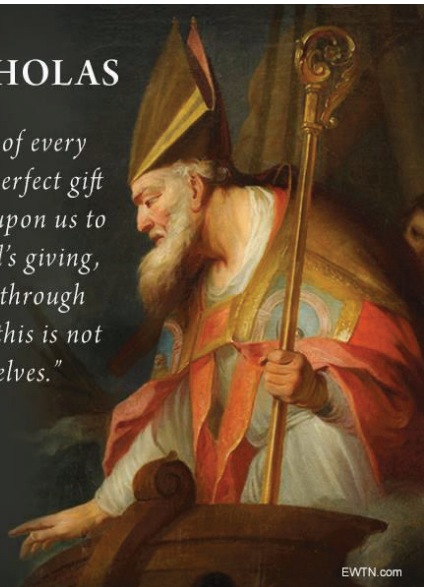


First Friday Adoration at St. Clement

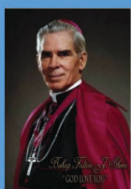

Advent: A Sense of the Season

The countdown to Christmas is on, and daily we hear of the number of shopping days left. Advent urges us also to focus on days- the day of the Lord and our being ready for it. In today's Gospel Jesus wants us to be vigilant, watchful and ready, not for the coming of Santa, but for His coming. Advent, which means "coming" or "arrival", focuses our attention on the ways Christ comes to us. In the first weeks of Advent, we focus on Christ's second coming in glory at the end of time. In late Advent, we recall how Jesus came to us 2000 years ago in Bethlehem. Thirdly, every day, during Advent and throughout the year, we pay attention to the ways our Lord comes to us in Word, prayer, the daily events of life, the sacraments and most especially in the sacrament of the Eucharist. Advent calls us to prepare our hearts and transform our lives. Prayer, reading, worship and acts of love and service are ways that open us up to God's transforming grace. Put your faith into action by doing good, being kind and patient, and lending a helping hand. Make a commitment to daily prayer and Sunday worship. Below is an Advent Wreath Blessing to use in your home this week. May these Advent days of the Lord be blessed ones for your family.

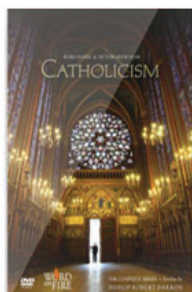
