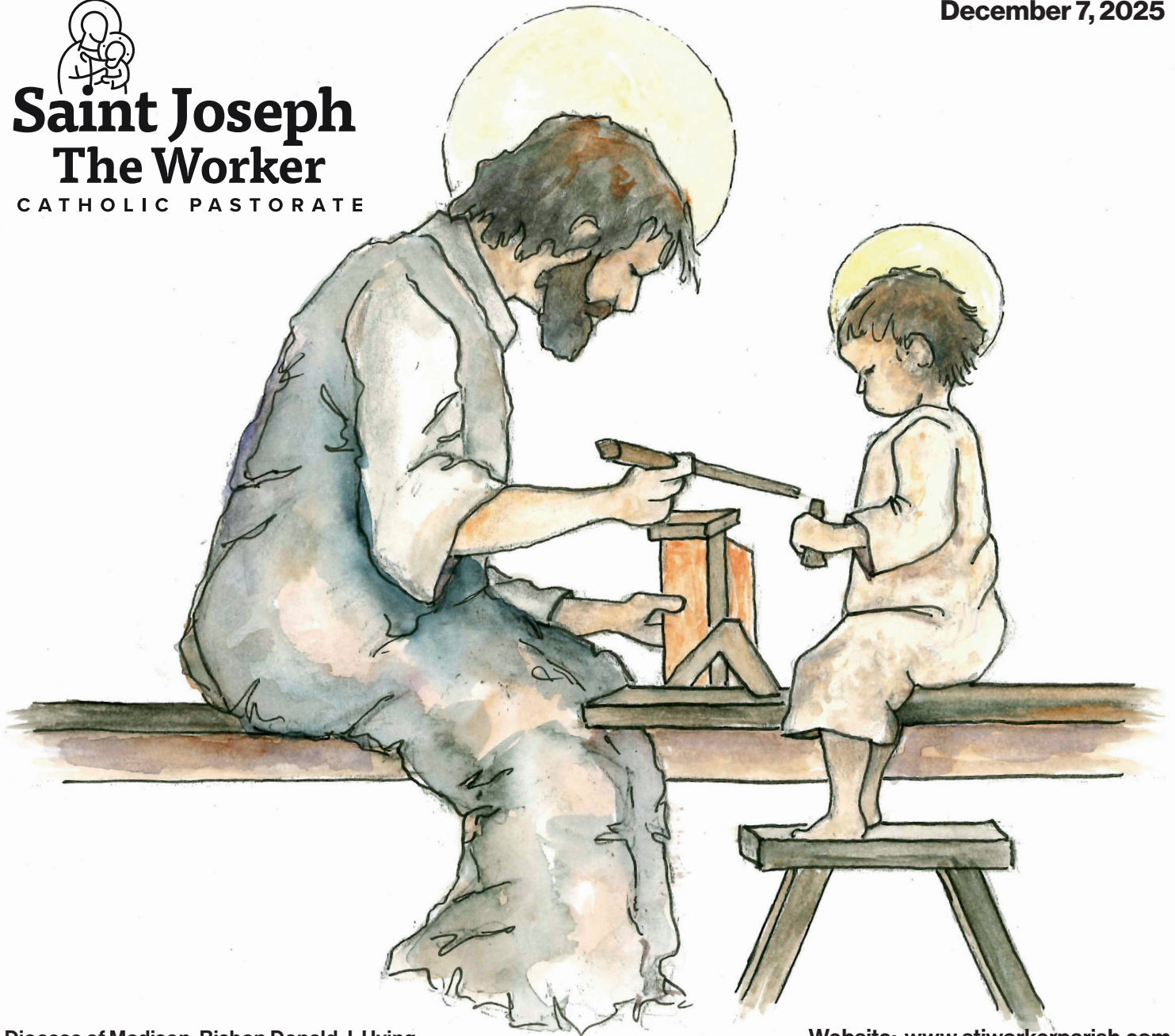

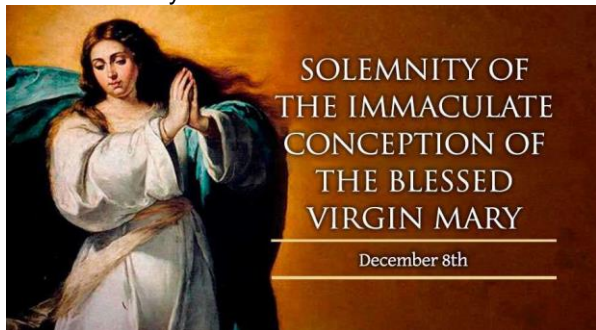
ST. MARY NEWS

There are expectations that go unmet. Family tensions and disagreements.
