#### **JUBILLE 2025 – PILGRIMS OF HOPE SOLEMNITY OF** THE BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST

"There is nothing more beautiful than to be surprised by the Gospel, by the encounter with Christ. There is nothing more beautiful than to know Him and to speak to others of our friendship with Him. These words are all the more significant if we think of the mystery of the Eucharist. The love that we celebrate in the sacrament is not something that we can keep to ourselves. By its very nature it demands to be shared with all.

What the world needs is God's love; it needs to encounter Christ and to believe in Him. The Eucharist is thus the source and summit not only of the Church's life, but also her mission: 'an authentically Eucharistic Church is a mission Church.' We too must be able to tell our brothers and sisters with conviction: "That which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us (1 Jn 1:3)."

Truly, nothing is more beautiful than to know Christ and to make Him known to others. The institution of the Eucharist, for that matter, anticipates the very heart of Jesus' mission: He is the one sent by the Father for the redemption of the world (Jn 3:16-17; Rom 8:32). At the Last Supper, Jesus entrusts to His disciples the sacrament which makes present His self-sacrifice for the salvation of us all, in obedience to the Father's will. We cannot approach the Eucharistic table without being drawn into the mission which, beginning in the very heart of God, is meant to reach all people. Missionary outreach is thus an essential part of the Eucharistic form of the Christian life." ~Pope Benedict, "The Sacrament of Charity" #84

"The bread that I give, is My flesh for the life of the world" (Jn 6:51) and "My flesh is real food, and my blood is real drink. He who feeds on My flesh and drinks My blood remains in Me and I in him (Jn 6:56)." At the ascension, Jesus promised to be with us always. The primary way in which He does so is through the Holy Eucharist. Jesus calls us to the Eucharistic table each week so that He can give Himself to us once more. Strengthened by the Lord's very Body & Blood, we are sent in peace "to love and serve the Lord."

#### **Ouestions for Reflection**

Do I come to Mass with expectation, anticipation and joy, knowing that Jesus wants to give Himself to me?

How does believing in the real presence of Jesus in the **Eucharist change my life?** 

Being fed by the Lord in the Eucharist, how do I bring Jesus to others? Through service, kindness, prayer, sharing my story and love for the Lord, inviting them to Mass?




# Congratulations Fr. Steve and Fr. Mark!


