We, the Catholic faith community of SS. Andrew-Thomas, strive to grow in our love and knowledge of Christ through worship, education, and service to others.

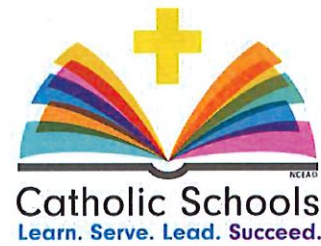
