The Parish Council Meeting of the St. Mary's Church of Bloomington was called to order on Tuesday, January 6th, 2026, at 6:30 pm with a prayer by Fr. Sudhakar. Members not present were Daniel Herbers, St. Joseph the Worker St. Mary Church/Bloomington Representative Melanie Mergen, Fr. Mark Miller and Fr. Steve Brunner. No members of the public were present.

**Financial Report:** Julie Jentz presented the annual financial report for July 1, 2025 through January 6, 2026. Church support and the Harvest Fund income is slightly down compared to last year. The Kenneth Kluesner Estate will be donating monetary funds to the Church. Fr. Steve Brunner will update us on the details of this donation in mid-to-late summer.

**St. Mary Fish Fry:** The St. Mary's Fish Fry will be Friday night, March 6th, 2026 serving from 4:30-7:00 pm. Melanie Mergen has ordered the fish, we are hoping to keep the dinner prices the same as last year. The meal, carry-outs and drive-through will all take place at the Church (the drive-through will be in the front of the Church). Motion (Gary) second (Chris) was made to keep the raffle prize money the same amounts as last year, on a voice call, motion carried. Set up for the dinner will be on Thursday March 5<sup>th</sup> with the time to be determined. Parish Council members will stuff envelopes for raffle tickets and work schedules on February 3<sup>rd</sup> at 6:30 pm prior to the next Council meeting. There will also be a Sports Raffle which will include a gun, knife, and fishing rods.
