





March MENTAL HEALTH MONDAYS Speaker Series

Our 4-week speaker series begins this week. Each night we will take a deeper look at an issue regarding Mental Health. Each evening will take place from 6:30-8 PM at one of our church locations. All in our communities are invited to join us!
