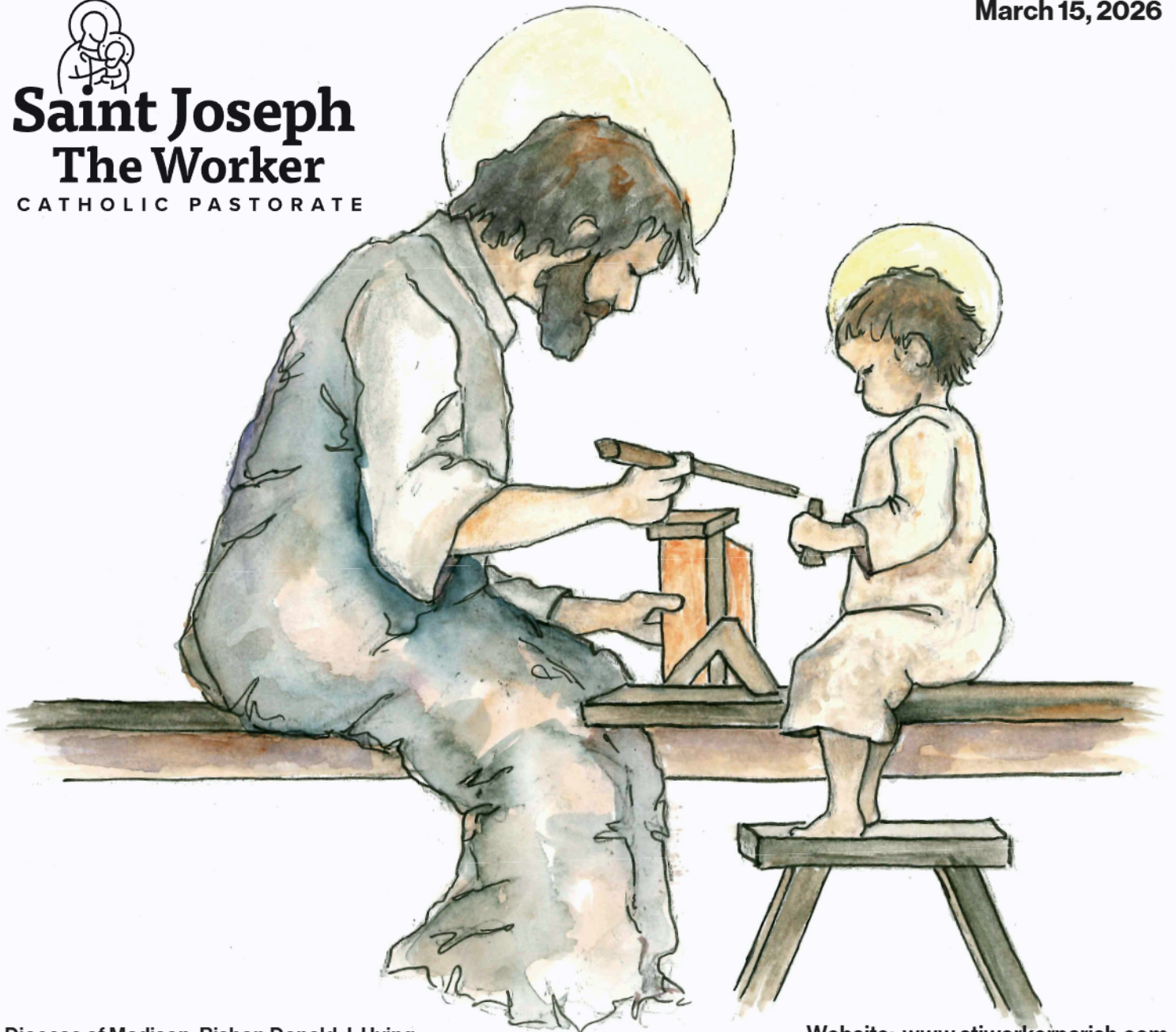

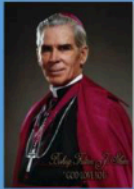

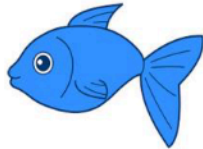

March MENTAL HEALTH MONDAYS Speaker Series

Thank you to those who attended Fr. Mick Moon's presentation on Faith and Mental Health. As a reminder, our speaker series is from 6:30 - 8 PM at one of our church locations. All people in our communities are invited to join us!

This week on Monday, March 16, Deacon Larry Tranel will discuss MINDSET STRATEGIES FOR BETTER MENTAL HEALTH. Sometimes I ask a group, "Who is the person you talk to the most?" Often the response is one's spouse or a relative. The truth is, though, that the person we talk to the most is ourselves! The question becomes, what is the self-talk that runs through our mind? How does what we say and what we do affect our overall mental health? Deacon Larry's presentation will take place at St. Charles School in Cassville, beginning at 6:30 PM.

Our series will conclude on March 23: IMPLEMENTING PARISH MENTAL HEALTH MINISTRY by Laura Sokup at Ss. Andrew-Thomas School in Potosi .
