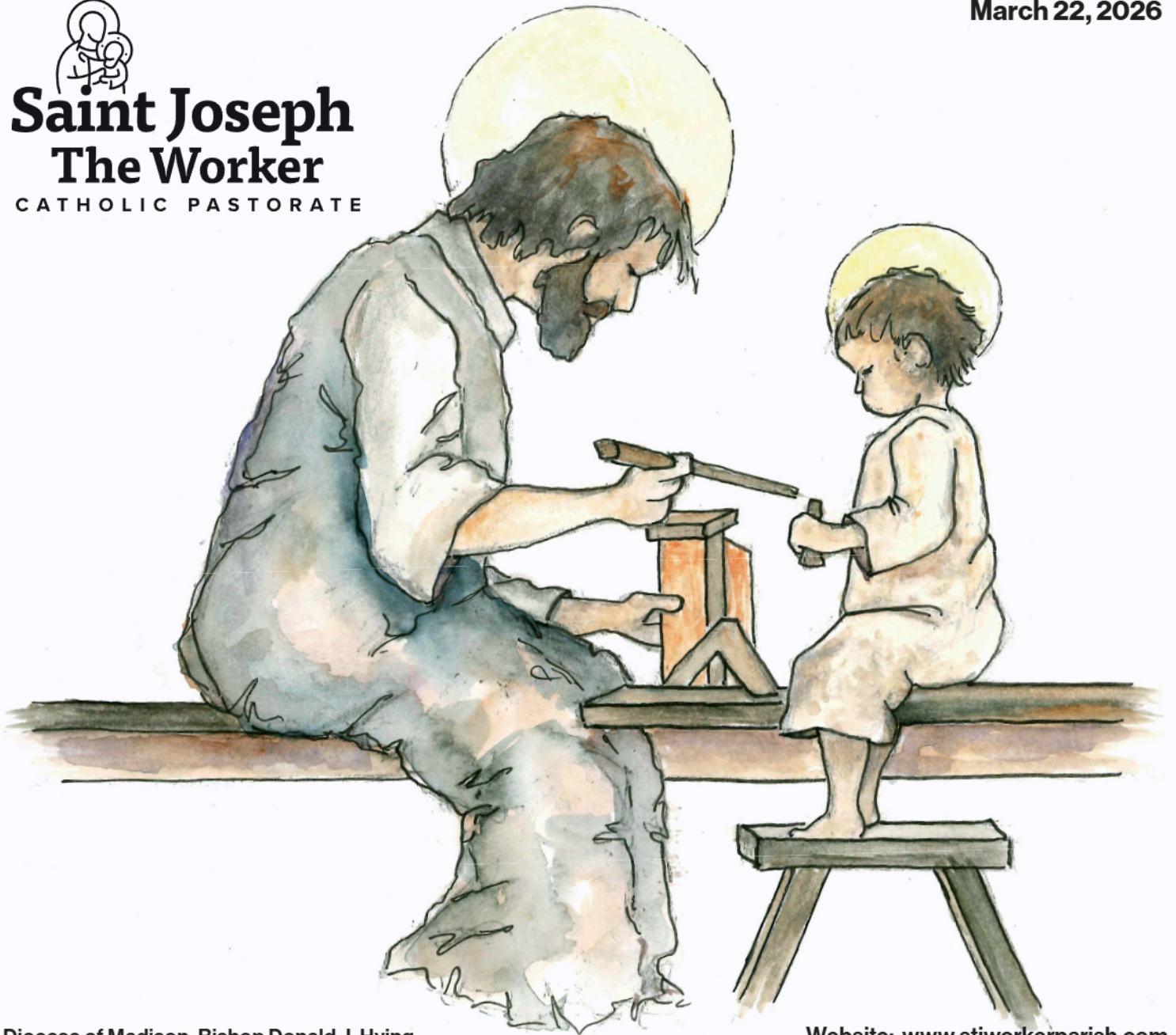

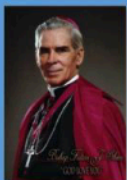

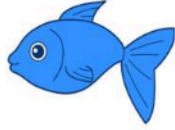

### Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Run

In 1960 Knights of Columbus Squires from Canada, United States and Mexico decided to honor Mary by "running" a natural rose from Ontario Canada and presented the Rose to her on her feast day, December 12, at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico. By the third year, it was the Running of the Silver Rose. In 1990s the Running of the Silver Rose became an official event for the Knights of Columbus. In 2001 the Knights reaffirmed the Run by recognizing the sacredness of life and Mary's position as the Mother of God and our Mother. As we continue this great annual tradition to honor Mary, we must continue asking her to accept our thanks and to intercede for our petitions. There are six Silver Roses. We are part of route 3 which started at Minnesota February 14th. The Rose arrives in Wisconsin March 15th. Knights will present the Silver Rose to Mary on December 12 at the Basilica in Monterrey.

The Rose will pass through St. Clement Church, Lancaster, WI on Friday, April 10th, at 5:30 PM for you to place your thanks and your petitions for Mary!!!! Tell your family. Tell your friends. With the problems that we have in this country, we should fill the church.

#### March MENTAL HEALTH MONDAYS Speaker Series

Thank you to those who braved a snowy Monday last week and attended Deacon Larry Tranel's presentation on Mindset Strategies for Better Mental Health. As a reminder, all people in our communities are invited to join us!

**Our speaker series concludes this week on Monday, March 23.** The topic will be "IMPLEMENTING PARISH MENTAL HEALTH MINISTRY" by Laura Sokup. Laura will give her presentation at Ss. Andrew-Thomas School in Potosi from 6:30-8:00 PM.

Laura will speak about some of the mental health resources that are available, both in-person and on-line, as well as the goals of the diocese. We will also be looking ahead a bit, and introducing the Mental Health Team in our St. Joseph the Worker pastorate.
