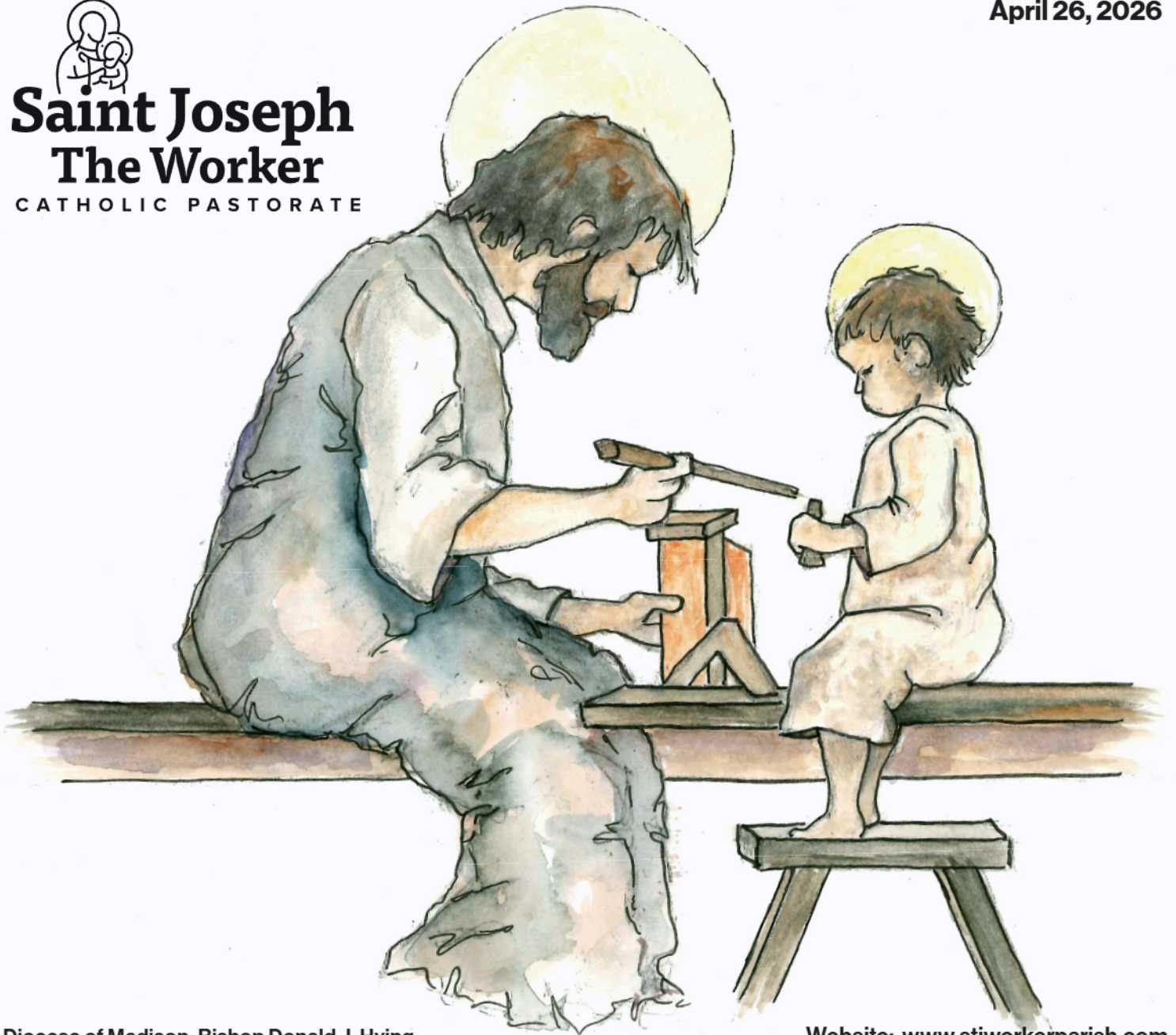

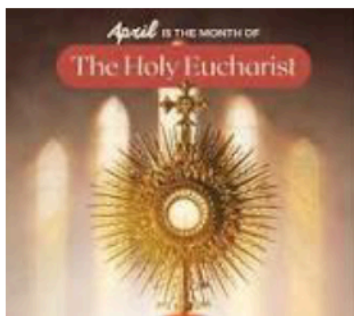

Mental Health Ministry

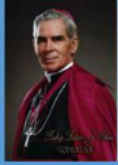

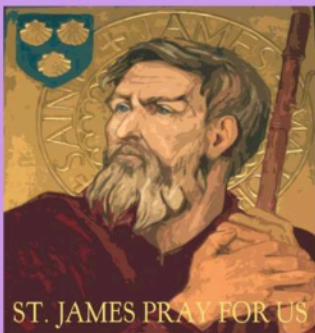

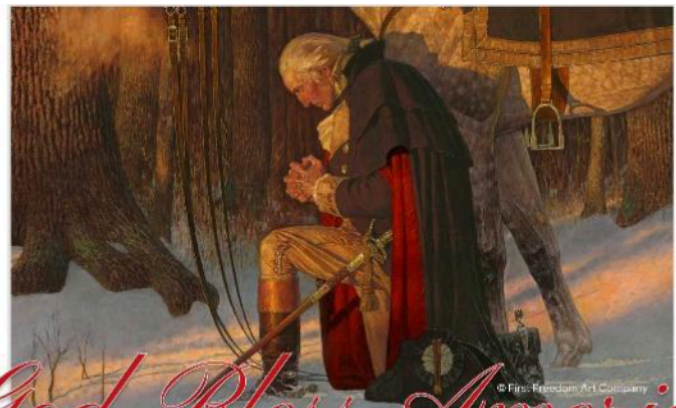
