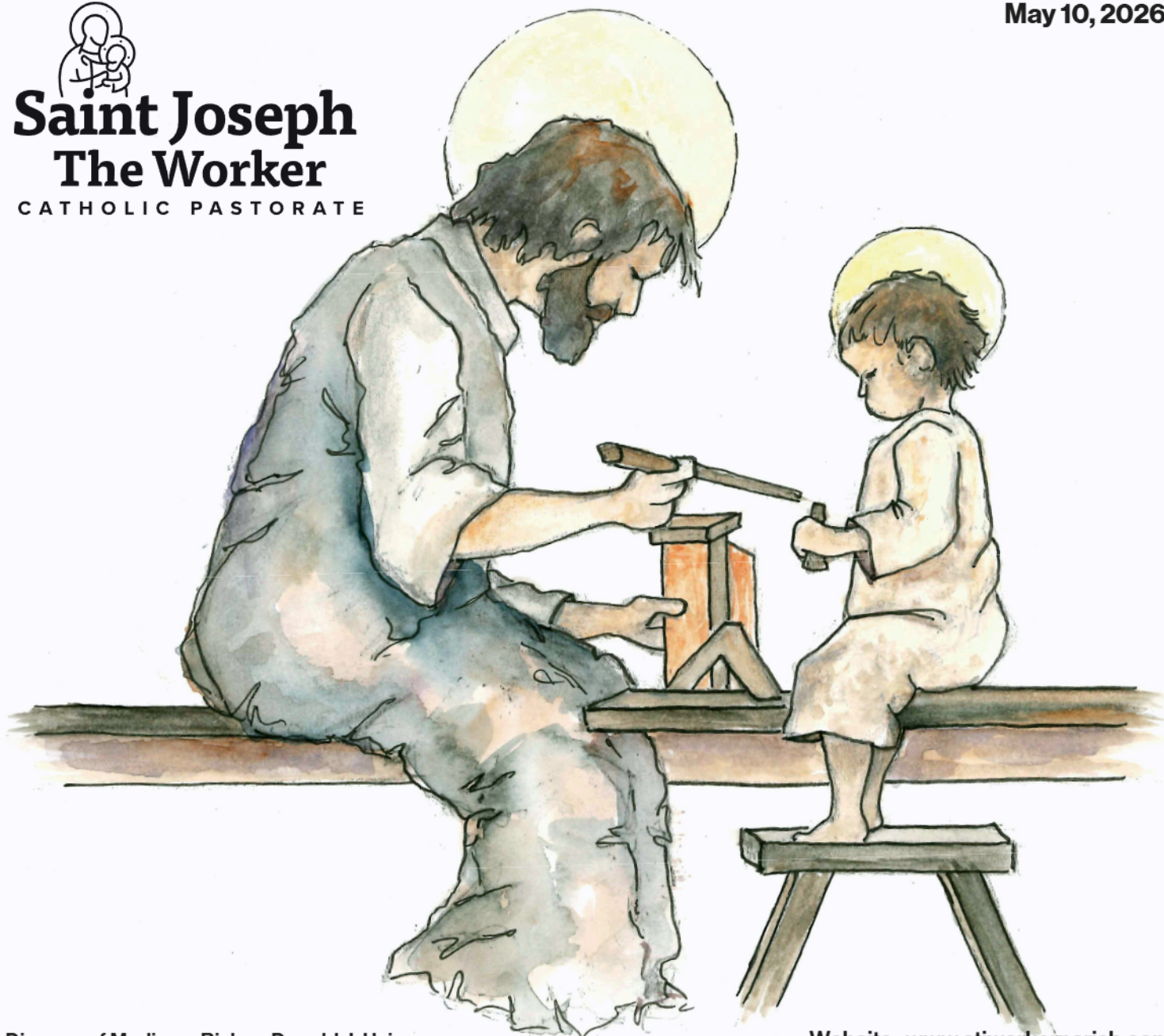

### Mowing Volunteers needed!

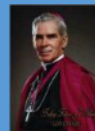

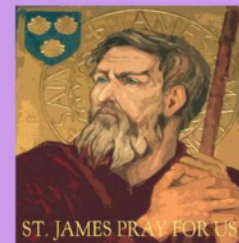

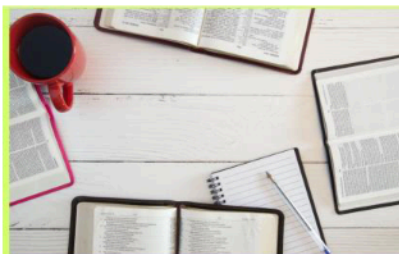
