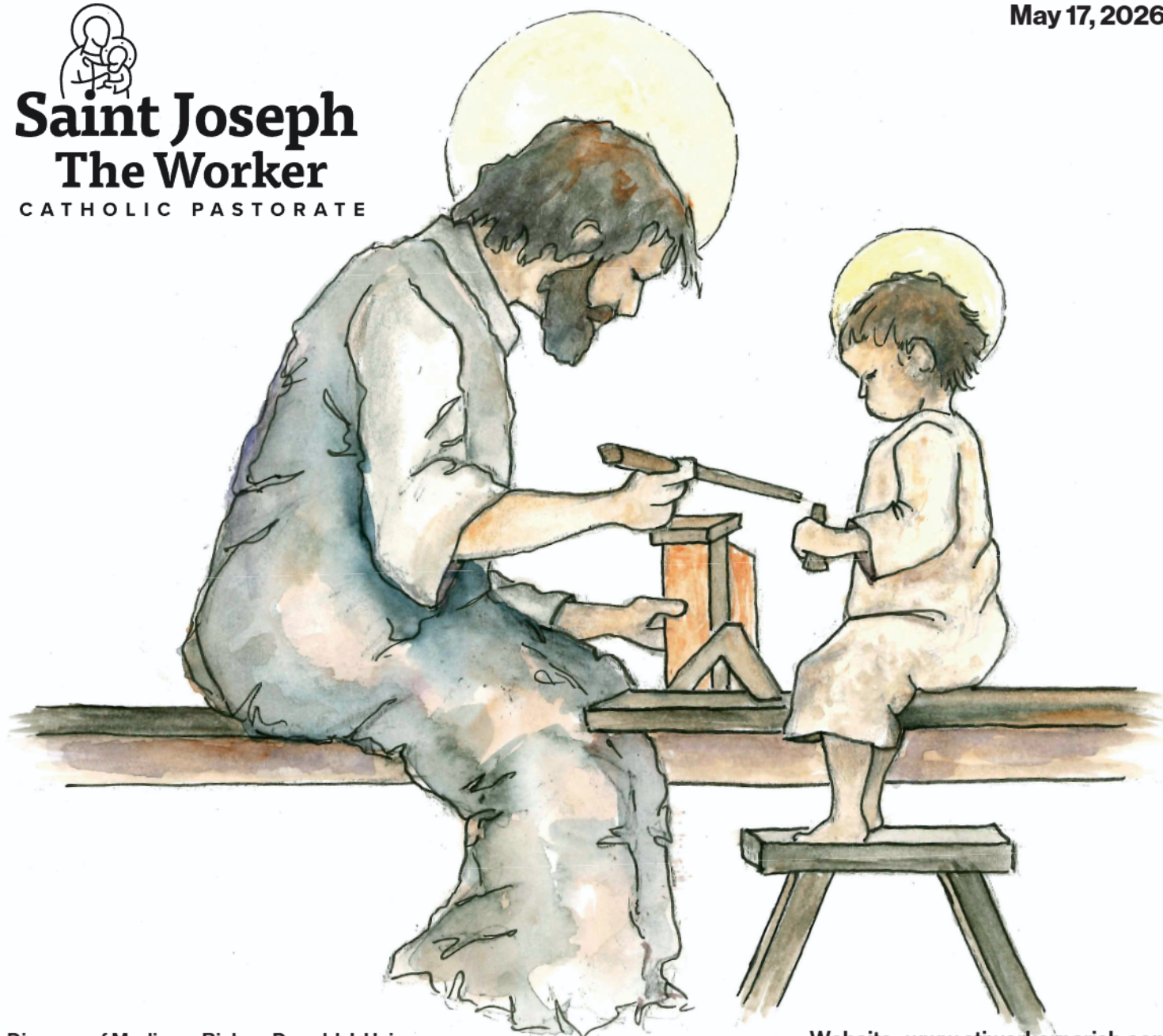

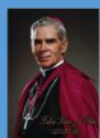

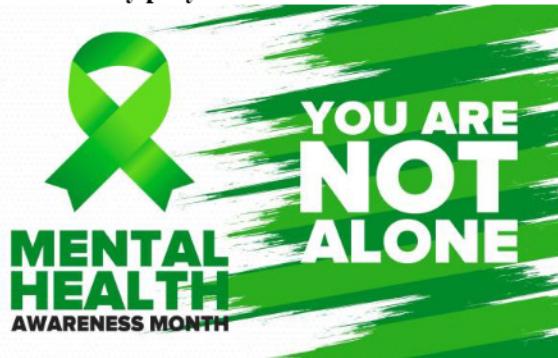
Mental Health Ministry HEALING BEGINS WITH COMMUNITY

May is Mental Health Awareness Month

Our pastorate mental health team, consisting of Kathy Bartels, Ann Boyle, Denise Dixon, Bill Manthe and Gail Steiner met recently to discuss potential mental health offerings. We discussed ways to reach out to youth, survivors of suicide, what we can do to prevent suicide and more. While nothing is solidified, we have numerous ideas that we will act upon. That said, last Friday, May 15, on the feast St. Dymphna, patron of those with mental illness, a Mass was held with the Intention: For those dealing with mental health challenges and their caregivers. This Mass was celebrated at Ss. Andrew-Thomas School. We also have a Mass scheduled for October 10 at 8 PM in Glen Haven for the same intention. October 10th is World Mental Health Day. Additionally, throughout this month one of the petitions prayed at the weekend Masses at all of the churches in our pastorate is related to mental health. With 1 in 5 people in our nation dealing with a mental health challenge of some kind, it would be appropriate to add these people and their families to your own daily prayers.



A Moment with the Bishop: Who Is the Man of the Shroud?

I would like to invite all in the Diocese of Madison to come and see a special exhibit on the Shroud of Turin that will be visiting St. Bernard Church in Middleton (part of Holy Cross Parish) from Tuesday, May 26 through Tuesday, June 2.

This traveling exhibit, developed by Othonia (a team of Shroud specialists within the Institute of Science and Faith at the Pontifical University Regina Apostolorum in Rome), presents what scientists, historians, and scholars have discovered about the Shroud of Turin, long venerated as the burial cloth of Jesus. Through immersive displays and engaging presentations, you will be invited to an encounter with the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ through the eyes of both reason and faith.

The exhibit will open at 5:00 pm on Tuesday, May 26. I will give a presentation titled "Exploring the Wonder of the Resurrection in the Four Gospels" at 6:00 pm that evening and then celebrate an opening Mass at 7:00 pm.

The full schedule of the exhibit's visiting hours and presentations can be found at madisondiocese.org/shroud. I hope you are able to visit this wonderful and inspiring exhibit!
