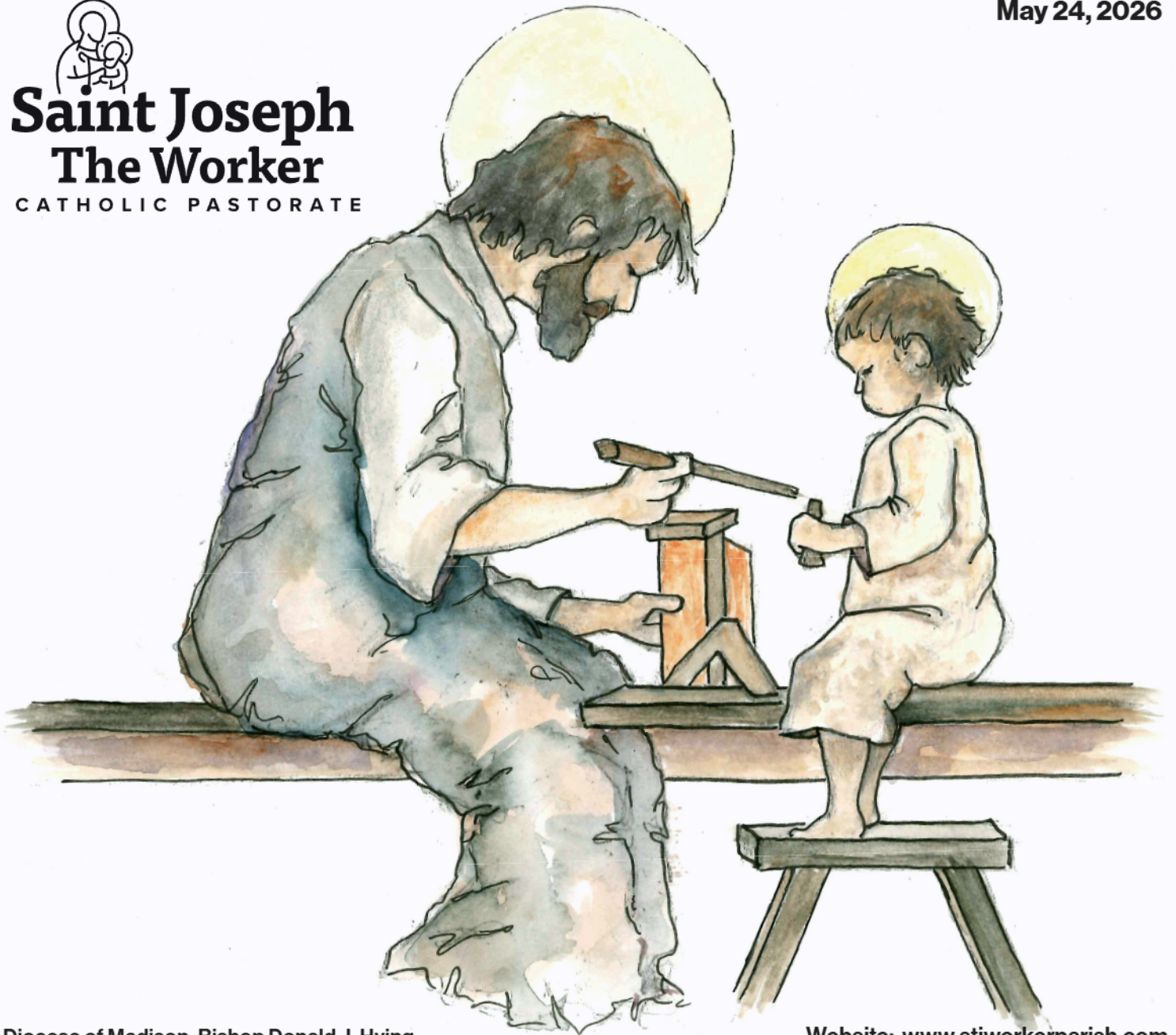

Mental Health Ministry

HEALING BEGINS WITH COMMUNITY

As many of you know, last weekend a relic of St. Dymphna, patron saint of those afflicted with mental illness, was in our pastorate. We were able to take the relic to four of our worship sites during their Masses, with a short prayer service and special blessing with her relic. It was very moving to tell the story of St. Dymphna, a young teen about 16 years of age, who was killed by her own father who's mental wellbeing spiraled downward following the death of his wife. Dymphna's father insisted that Dymphna marry him, which abhorred her on many levels. This led to her fleeing from Ireland to a town in modern day Belgium called Gheel. In time, her father found her whereabouts and came to take her back to Ireland and to marry her. Her continued refusal and his darkened mind led him to kill her by beheading. After her death in the 600's, a shrine and church were built over her grave where many miracles were attributed to her intercession. Today pilgrims continue to go to Gheel to seek healing at her tomb, and also at the local mental health clinic, with citizens welcoming the pilgrims into their homes, treating them with compassion. As moving as it was to tell her story, what was even more moving was the number of people who stayed after Mass to pray and to be blessed with her relic. We had many people say, "thank you for doing this."

Most of us do not have a diagnosed mental illness. But many of us experience times of darkness where we feel hopeless, alone and isolated with no one to talk to. This can often lead to greater darkness and loneliness. When this happens, reach out to the Suicide and Crisis Line at 988. Look up resources at the diocese by going to

www.madisondiocese.org/mentalhealth. You can always reach out to one of the members of our pastorate mental health team: Kathy Bartels, Ann Boyle, Denise Dixon, Bill Manthe and Gail Steiner. Or turn to a trusted friend. The important thing is to reach out, as there is help and there is hope. Additionally, reach out to God in prayer.



A Moment with the Bishop: Who Is the Man of the Shroud?

I would like to invite all in the Diocese of Madison to come and see a special exhibit on the Shroud of Turin that will be visiting St. Bernard Church in Middleton (part of Holy Cross Parish) from Tuesday, May 26 through Tuesday, June 2.

This traveling exhibit, developed by Othonia (a team of Shroud specialists within the Institute of Science and Faith at the Pontifical University Regina Apostolorum in Rome), presents what scientists, historians, and scholars have discovered about the Shroud of Turin, long venerated as the burial cloth of Jesus. Through immersive displays and engaging presentations, you will be invited to an encounter with the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ through the eyes of both reason and faith.

The exhibit will open at 5:00 pm on Tuesday, May 26. I will give a presentation titled "Exploring the Wonder of the Resurrection in the Four Gospels" at 6:00 pm that evening and then celebrate an opening Mass at 7:00 pm.

The full schedule of the exhibit's visiting hours and presentations can be found at madisondiocese.org/shroud. I hope you are able to visit this wonderful and inspiring exhibit!

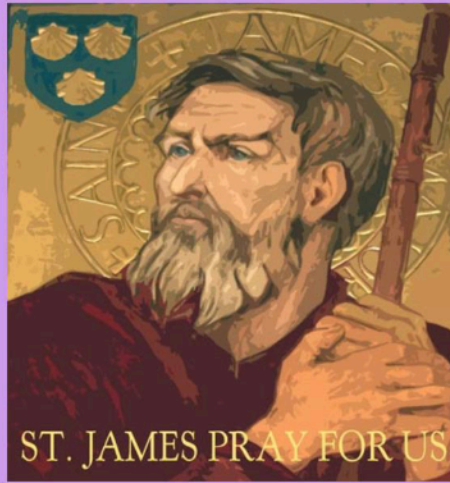


