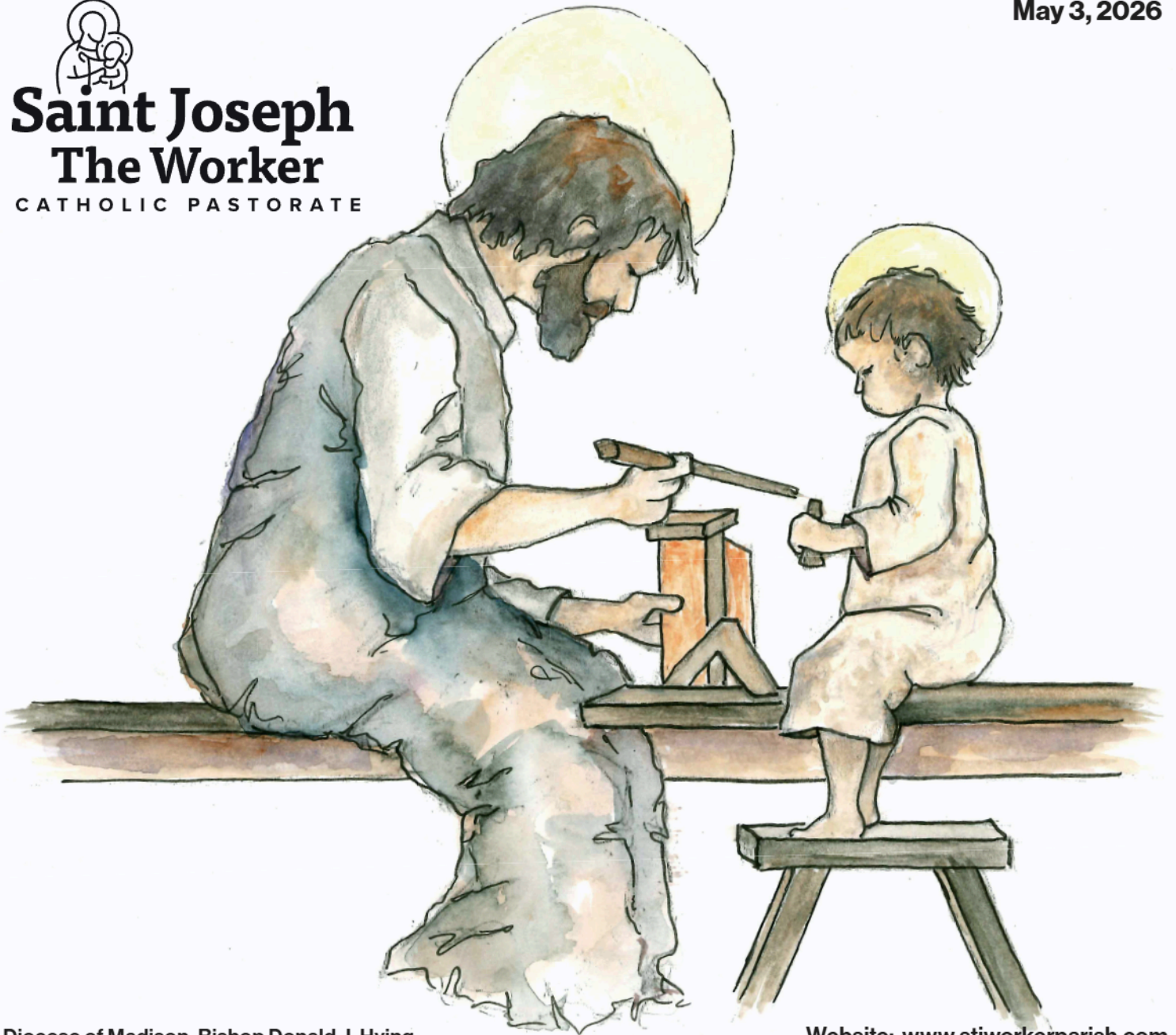

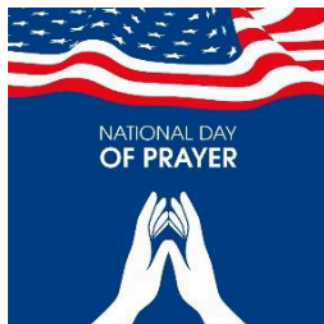

Mental Health Ministry

HEALING BEGINS WITH COMMUNITY

May is Mental Health Awareness Month. However, this month is about more than awareness, as we all know people who struggle with mental health challenges that are on-going or occur occasionally. Those who struggle may even be ourselves or a member of our family.

Mental Health Awareness Month is also about being present and supporting one another. This past Saturday, April 25, five people from our pastorate took part in the International Association of Catholic Mental Health Ministers Accompaniment Connection Training (A.C.T.). In this training we learned three important L's of accompaniment: Look (notice that someone may be struggling or in distress); Listen (be a compassionate, Christ-like presence with this person, listen with the head and heart); and Link (connect people with available resources, which may include family, helping professionals, support groups, etc.). 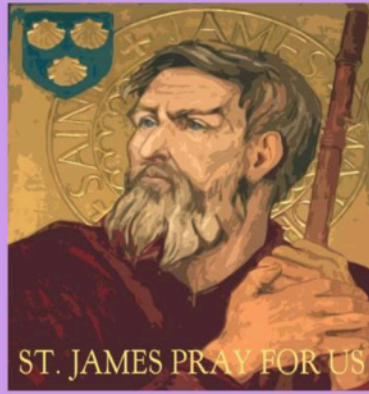
Great Start

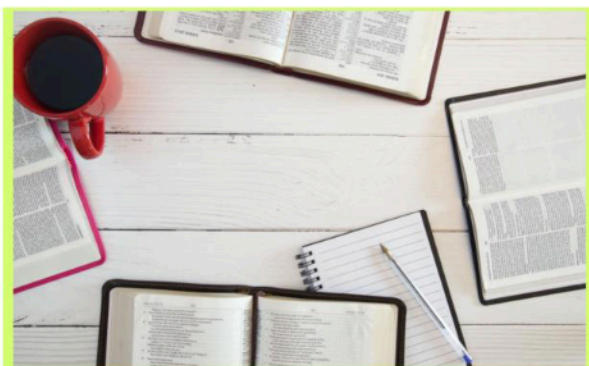
MECHANICS OF A MINDSET



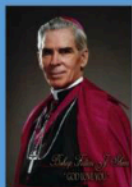
"Do not be conformed to the Spirit of this age, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind." (Rom 12:2)
