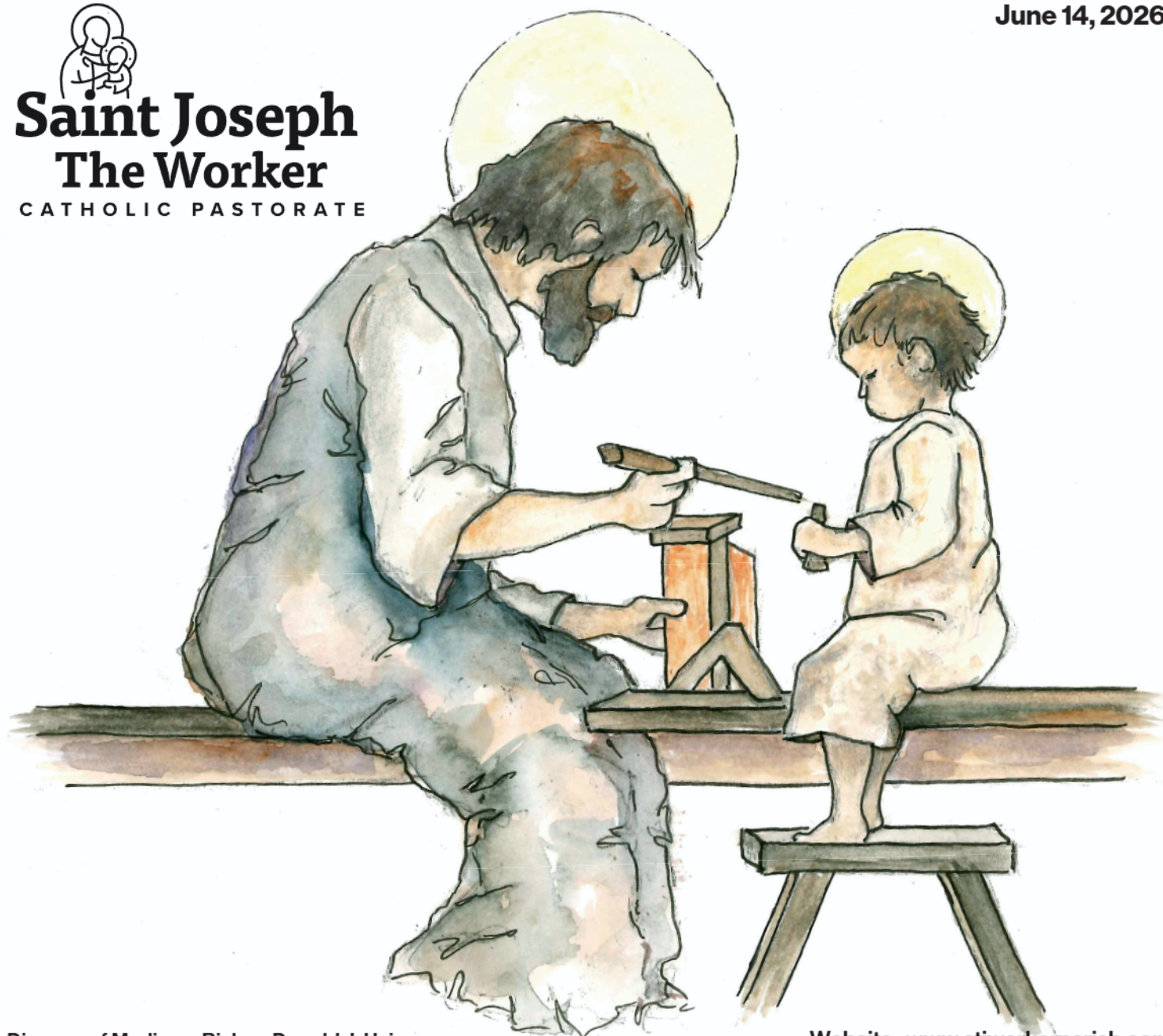

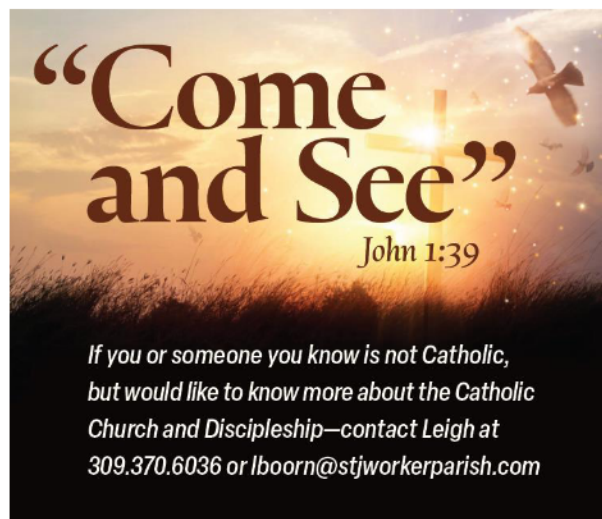

HEALING BEGINS WITH COMMUNITY

Many of you probably read the article last week in the Grant County Herald Independent titled, "Families In Crisis: A Rural Health Special Report." It was an excellent article and we will be looking forward to the follow-up article about reaching out for help in this week's paper. If you didn't get a chance to see the article, it focused on the lack of mental health resources in the area, especially in cases where law enforcement is called to intervene. They are the main responders, when often the person needs someone trained in mental health to assist also. The article also focused on the increase in mental health issues with youth. Rural communities often lack the basic mental health resources for people of all ages found in larger cities. The article concluded with a list of hotlines. You may want to consider clipping this out to have on hand. Having this resource close by can make a difference in the life of a loved one.

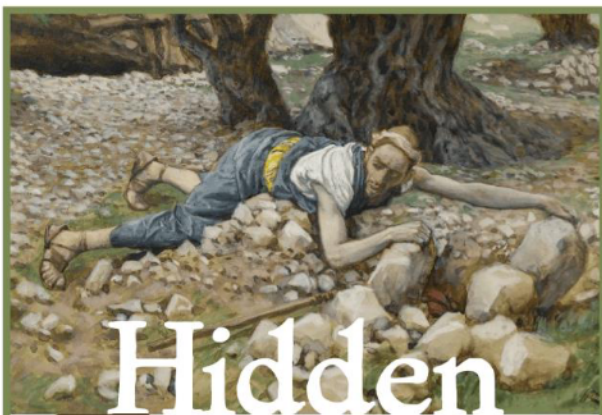

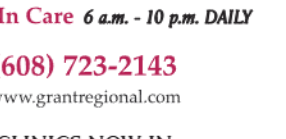

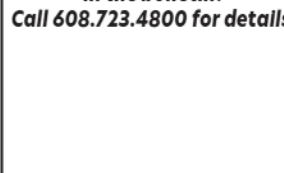
