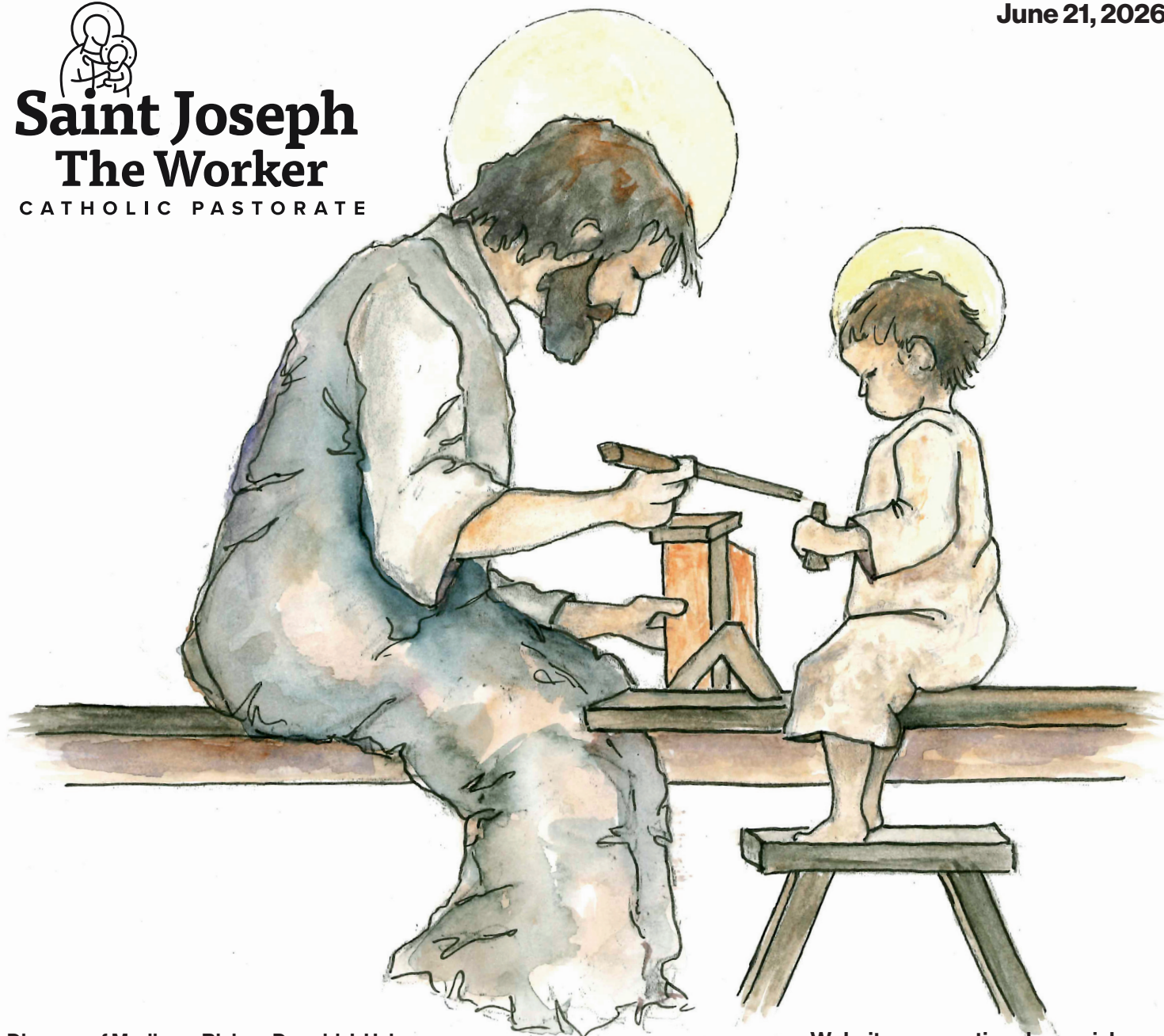

Mental Health Ministry

HEALING BEGINS WITH COMMUNITY

Last week our Mental Health Advocate Team met to discuss potential upcoming offerings. Many of these were based off the feedback from the Mental Health Speaker Series that was held during Lent. Below is a brief summary of some of the things we have planned for the remainder of 2026.

- Develop a Mental Health Facebook page for our pastorate as well as a designated email address for mental health.
- Sometime in early fall, Megan Wedwick and Laura Sokup from the Diocesan Office of The Apostolate for Persons with Disabilities will give a presentation on Suicide and Suicide Prevention. This will be held at one of our pastorate churches.
- In September, a member of the pastorate Mental Health Team will speak briefly after the weekend Masses at each of the churches regarding various means of communicating with members of our churches, and ways that people can reach out to one of us.
- Also in September, the annual Diocesan Mental Health Retreat will be at Camp Gray on Saturday, September 19. This was a terrific event last year, and we hope many from our pastorate can attend this year. Carpooling will be available.
- We will be offering an Emmaus Retreat on Saturday, October 10. This retreat is for parents who have lost a child at any time, by any means, and at any age. Registration details will be coming in July.
- Mental Health Mass Intention will be at St. Mary, Help of Christians Church in Glen Haven on Saturday, October 10 at 8 PM. October 10 is Mental Health Awareness Day. We discussed many more items which we will share with you once we have more details. Also, there will be a suicide prevention training in Richland Center on July 22 from 11-3. LivingWorks safeTALK is a four-hour training that equips people to be more alert to someone thinking of suicide and better able to connect them with further help. Using a simple yet effective model, LivingWorks safeTALK empowers everyone to make a difference. There is no cost to attend, and registration closes on July 10. 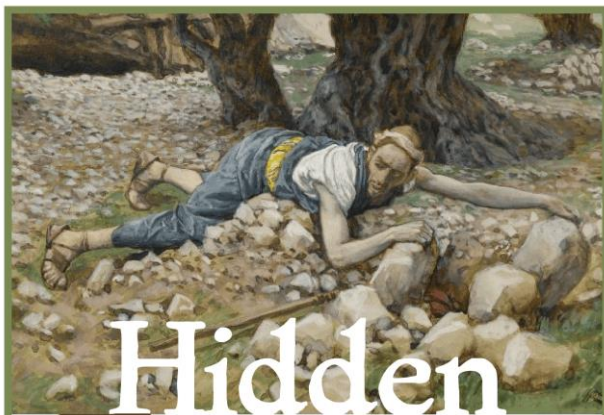


FAMILY PROMISE of Grant County Info & Updates



Did you know that in the 2024-25 school year in the Lancaster School District, there were two school-age children identified as homeless? In the same school year, that number was 38 in the Platteville Area Schools, and 3 in the River Ridge District. In addition to what was reported, we know that the number of children who are homeless is much higher in these districts and throughout Grant County. First, there is under-reporting by youth and parents who do not disclose that they are homeless. Second, the reporting only identifies school-age children. Babies and children who are of pre-school age are not reported in the above numbers. Thus, the numbers of homeless children 18 years and younger is very significant in our county. Just one homeless child is one too many.

Family Promise of Grant County exists to give families with children who are experiencing homelessness a place to call home when they do not have permanent shelter. It exists to provide warm meals, a place to sleep, and stability and safety. FPGC was established because there was a need, and the need to care for homeless families with kids still exists. Presently there are 7 host churches, plus a number of support churches caring for families that are part of FPGC. The next host week for St. Clement begins the week of July 12. You can help make a difference in the lives of children and their parents by volunteering in this important ministry and mission.
