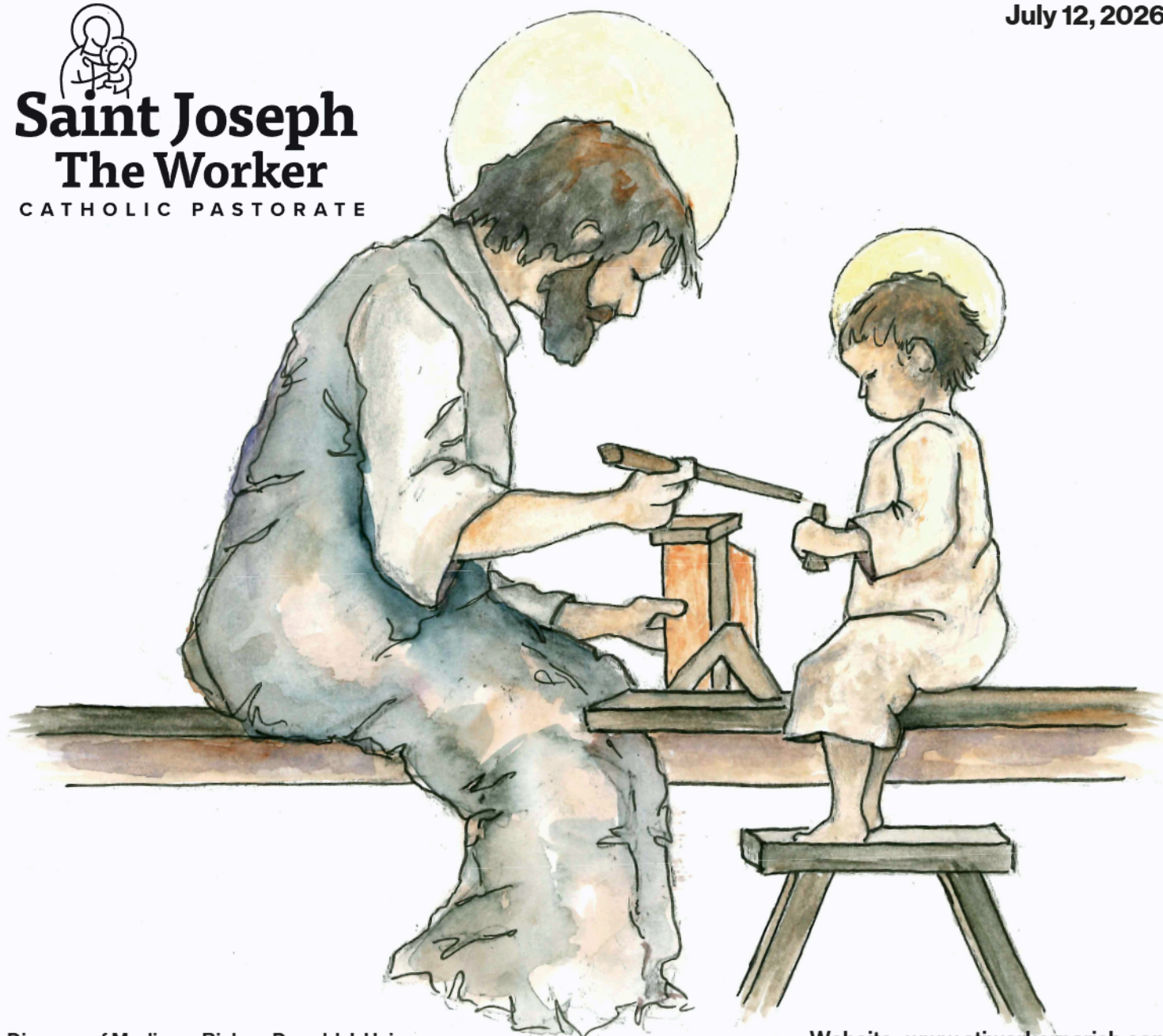

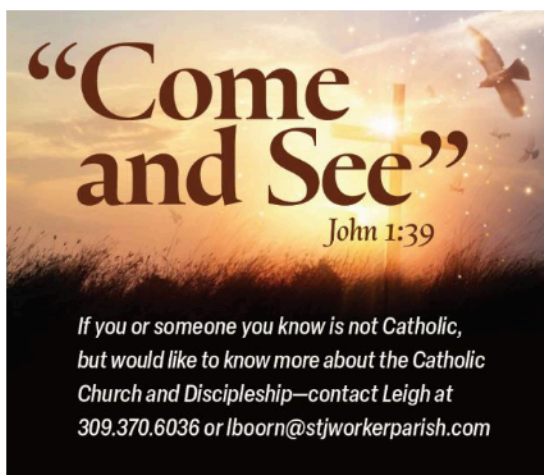

Healing Begins With Community

- On Saturday, October 10, an Emmaus Retreat will be offered in our pastorate at St. Clement Church. Emmaus Ministry is a national organization, and its focus is to support parents who are grieving the death of their son or daughter within a retreat setting. The retreat is for any parent who has experienced the death of a child at any time, by any cause, and at any age. I (Bill Manthe) participated in the recent Emmaus Retreat in Footville, and I can attest that it was a powerful experience, even with my daughter's death being 31 years ago.

The retreat on October 10 at St. Clement will begin at 9:30 am and end at 7:30 pm. The retreat is open to anyone who has experienced the death of a child, not just members of our pastorate. The death may have happened years ago or in recent months. It may have happened pre-birth or when the son or daughter was 50+ and any time in between. The death can have taken place by any cause. This retreat is open to any parent who grieves for their child. To register, go to: www.emfgp.org/10-10-26-lancaster-wi-registration-form/. - The annual Diocesan Mental Health Retreat will be held at Camp Gray on Saturday, September 19. This was a terrific event last year, and we hope many from our pastorate can attend this year. - The Pope's Prayer Intention for July is: "For respect and protection for human life at all its stages, recognizing it as a gift from God." On the second Monday of the month, there is a reflection and prayer for Mental Health that ties with the Pope's Intention. It follows:

"People who live with a mental illness can lead lives of faith and courage. But all too often the lives of people who are struggling with a serious mental illness are not valued and shown respect. The value of a person's life is not diminished because they live with a serious mental illness. Christ always loves people who are frail and vulnerable and gives them hope. Pope Leo XIV said to a woman who lived with serious depression and survived a suicide attempt, "through contact with Jesus, even those who feel lost regain confidence in life ... they can rise to live again." The Holy Father reminds us that "Life is a gift...even in the midst of pain and suffering. Let us pray for the respect and protection of human life in all its stages, recognizing it as a gift from God."

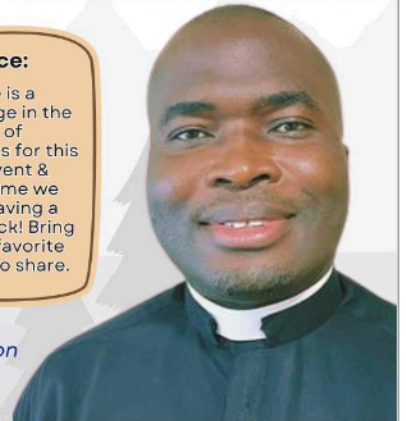
