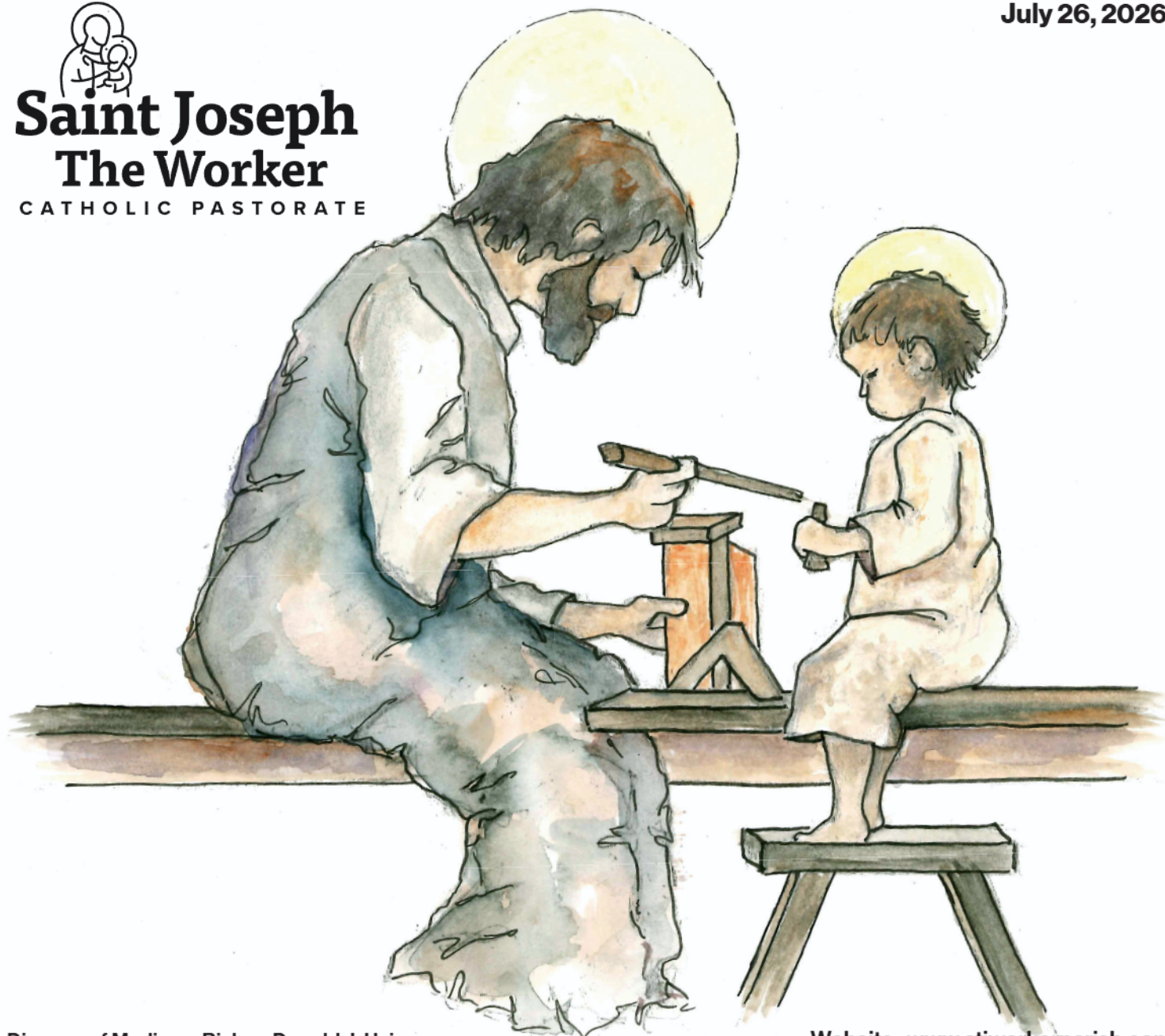

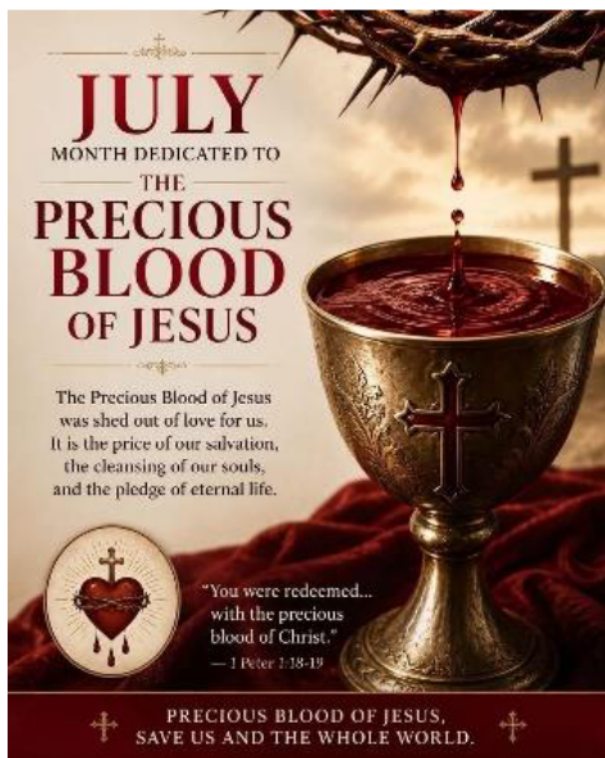

Healing Begins With Community

Caring For Those Who Have Lost A Loved One To Suicide:

Suicide touches families, friends, parishes and communities. In all likelihood, we all know someone who has died by suicide. How can we, as people of faith, respond?

Join us for an interactive presentation with Laura Sokup, APSW, and Mental Health Program Coordinator for the Diocese of Madison, on how to accompany and support those grieving the loss of a loved one to suicide. 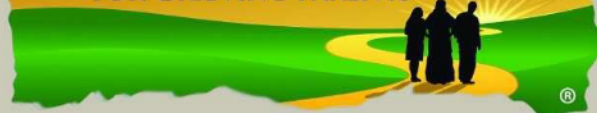

GRIEF SHARE - A Support Group for the Bereaved

When a loved one dies, it can feel like you are alone. Few people understand the thoughts, feelings and the pain you are experiencing. This can lead to isolation, feelings of depression and extreme sadness and sorrow. All of these are normal. Yet, there is support through GriefShare. GriefShare is a 13 session support group for those who have experienced the loss of a loved one. A GriefShare session includes an informative video, discussion and sharing. It is said that "grief shared is grief diminished." Our next GriefShare support group will begin on August 20, from 6:00 to 7:30 PM. We will meet in the St. Clement Parish office meeting room.
