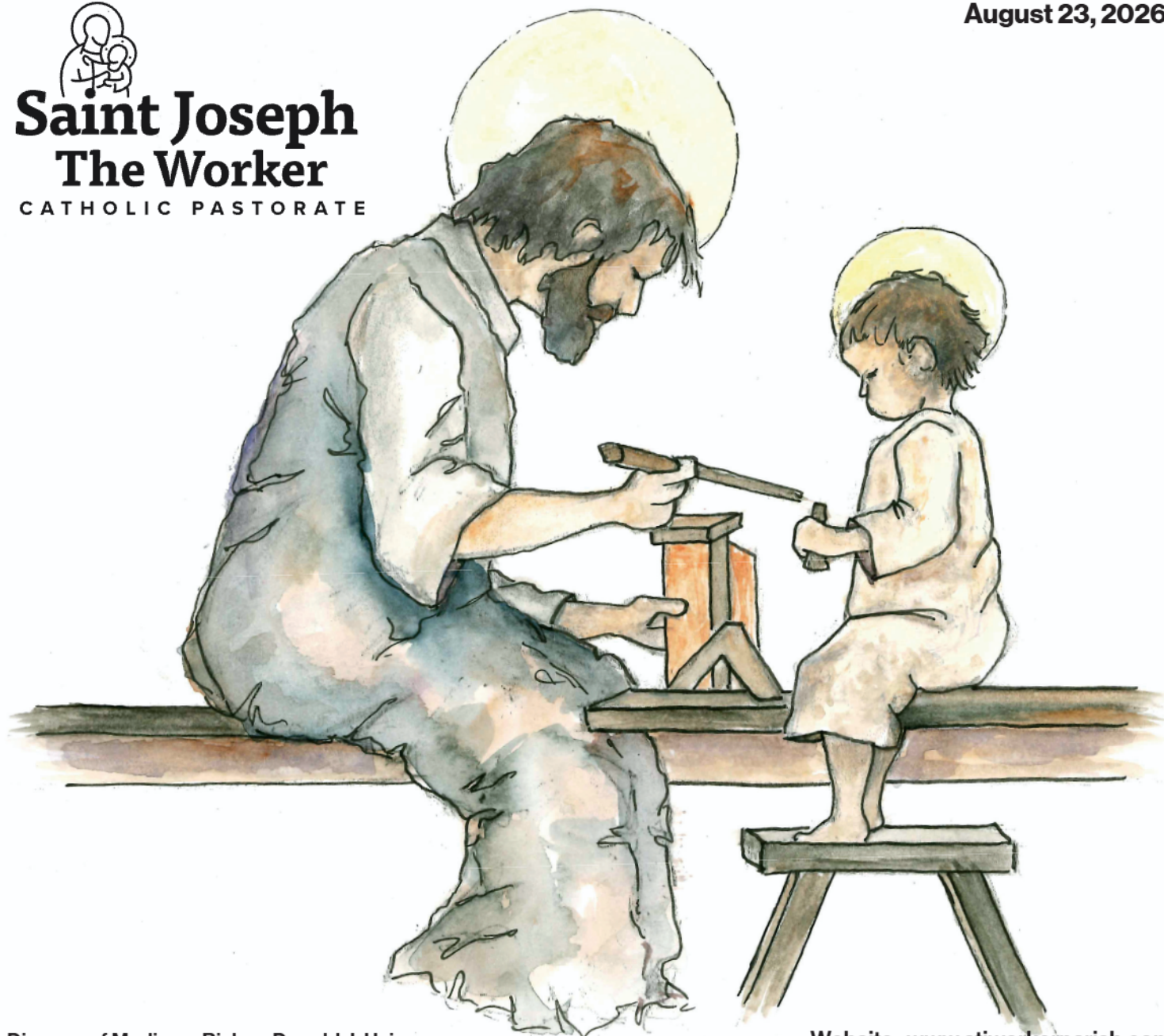

- **Caring For Those Who Have Lost A Loved One To Suicide**

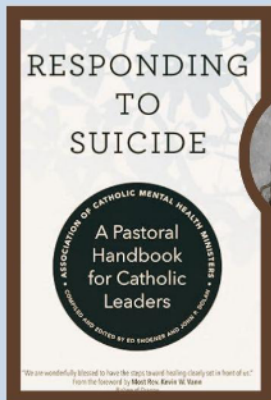
When suicide occurs, we are often left without words. We don't know what to say to the family and friends of the person who died by suicide. We fear saying something wrong, or that by saying something, we will cause pain to the family. So how can we support loved ones after a suicide? Laura Sokup, mental health coordinator for the diocese, will be giving a presentation on how to support those grieving the loss of a loved one to suicide. This presentation will be held on Thursday, September 10, from 6:00–8:00 p.m. at St. Clement Catholic Church. Registration is recommended by emailing Bill Manthe at wgmanthe@yahoo.com.

- **EMMAUS RETREAT** is for any parent who is grieving the death of a son or daughter at any age, at any time and by any cause. GRIEF SHARE

A Support Group for the Bereaved

When a loved one dies, it can feel like you are alone. Few people understand the thoughts, feelings and the pain you are experiencing. This can lead to isolation, feelings of depression and extreme sadness and sorrow. All of these are normal and there is support through GriefShare. GriefShare is a 13 session support group for those who have experienced the loss of a loved one. A GriefShare session includes an informative video, discussion and sharing. It is said that "grief shared is grief diminished." Our next GriefShare support group began on August 20, from 6:00 to 7:30 PM on Thursdays. We meet in the St. Clement Parish office meeting room. 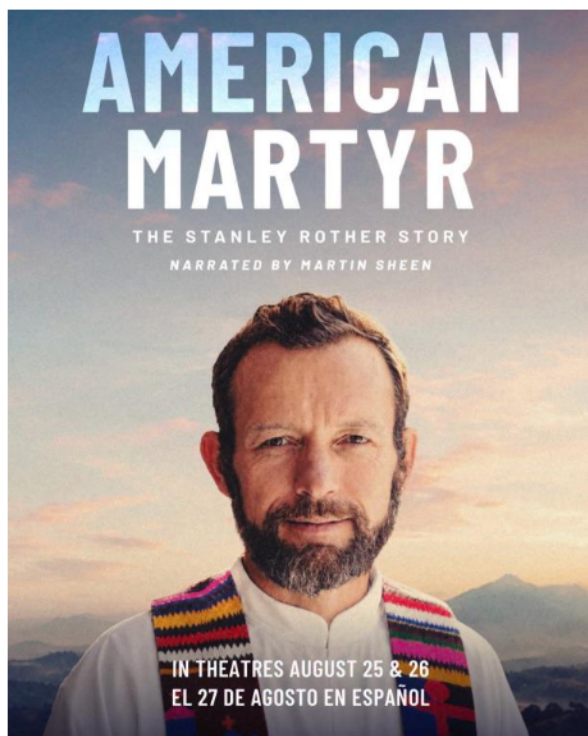
