FROM THE PASTOR

"God does not abandon us but always seeks, waits for, and accompanies us, even to the point of placing Himself, helpless, into our hands". - Pope Francis on the solemnity of Corpus Christi, 2024

into our hands. And into our mouths.

On this Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, let's stop and think about the radical meaning of what our late Holy Father said, above: Jesus Christ, truly and really present in the sacrament, entrusts his mission to you.

When the Holy Eucharist is placed into your hands or upon your tongue, you say 'Amen,' and with that you publicly affirm your belief in and commitment to Christ. What does that commitment to Christ look like in everyday life? It might be helpful to reflect upon these questions:

Do you like Jesus or do you love him? Do you like Jesus because of his ideas, or what he says, or how he acts? Do you strive to be like him or just admire him from afar? Are you a superficial fan or a true follower?

Awhile back, I heard a Catholic podcast where the guy said something that really surprised me: "Sometimes," he said, "I think Jesus is sick of believers, when really, He wants more followers."

Activated Disciple," says something very similar when he offers this observation: "There's difference" he says, "between being a fan of Jesus — and being a follower. There is a danger in simply being someone who may be 'on fire,' loves the faith, watches and listens to Catholic radio and TV, orders Catholic CDs and even has Catholic bumper stickers." These are all VERY good things, of course — but "the danger," he says, "lies in the fact that you can, without knowing it, exchange a dynamic, daily relationship with Jesus with simply consuming the faith."

If we are honest, all of us can see this tendency in our own hearts.

We happen to really like what Jesus says and does. We are inspired by His example.

When He says: "Love your enemies," we are captivated by the beauty and the power of His words. When He says: "There's no greater love than to die for your friends," we feel a surge of desire to do the same. His parables make us think about the ways we could be more merciful, more humble, selfless. When He favors the lowly,

Jesus quite literally places himself Jeff Cavins, in his book "The the sick, the poor, the powerless, the widow and the orphan... when he tells us: "Deny yourself, take up your Cross, and follow me" there's a deep and abiding sense that this is the way we want to live and act all the time.




> Rarely do we love people the way they deserve to be loved, the way that God loves...



- At Jesus's table, we can invite others. By week's end, our young people were not just guests at the table. They were ready to share the invitation with others.






JUBILEE 2025: PILGRIMS OF HOPE


