

FROM THE PASTOR

Good intentions can get lost in the hustle and bustle of life. That is, we want to help others, we want to reach out, we want to live a life of Christian service and mission. We just wish we had more time to sit down and write a note of gratitude or call and offer words of comfort and forgiveness. But who has the time? We are all so busy.

We have good intentions, but they land on the sidelines of our hectic lives. How can we change this so that our good and Godly intentions can take root and bear fruit?

To start with, we must realize that time is not the master of our lives. Instead, we should learn to master time so that it is at the service of God's mission. We can do this by creating a rule of life that helps us live more intentionally, by embracing every moment as an

opportunity to love as Jesus loved. "As I have loved you," he said, "so you must love one another."

Loving as Jesus loved may sound challenging, but it can be as simple as deciding to accompany at least one person a month to lead them closer to Jesus. It might mean just having coffee with someone once a week to pray; it might mean listening to someone's story with no judgment, no advice, only love; it may even mean sitting intentionally with your spouse or teenager or toddler to listen, really listen, and love as Jesus loved – totally, completely, without counting the cost.

Good intentions do not have to get lost. They just need your attention, because there is a big difference between good intentions and intentional living. Good intentions need a plan so that you become an intentional disciple, so that the Good News can be shared. You are the hands, the feet, the heart of Jesus in your corner of the world – at the kitchen table, on the soccer field, or behind your desk. Be a bearer of that Good News, intentionally, every moment of every day.




JUBILEE 2025: PILGRIMS OF HOPE

On February 15, 2025, over 40,000 faithful gathered for a powerful pilgrimage to Komarock Hill in Kenya's Wote Diocese. Once a sacred site for the Kamba people, Komarock has become a place of deep Catholic devotion, believed to be touched by the divine.

Steeped in mystery, Komarock is known for its historical apparitions, unexplained phenomena, and resistance to destruction, all of which point to its spiritual significance. Now consecrated as a Catholic shrine, it continues to draw pilgrims seeking healing, prayer, and a deeper connection with God.

The pilgrimage was led by Bishop Norman King'oo Wambua, Apostolic Administrator of Wote Diocese, and marked a powerful moment of unity and faith for the people of Kenya.
