

Hands of Grace

EST. FOUNDATION 2025

The people of Mary, Queen of Peace have a heart for service, and it shows.

It shows in the way you respond when there is a need – whether after a hurricane, an earthquake, a flood, or a fire. It shows when there is a collection for the poor, the homeless, or the marginalized. Christian service is in our parish DNA.

Recognizing this, Fr. Robert Cooper, pastor, wanted to enshrine this heart for service into something lasting. That is how the Hands of Grace Foundation was born. This non-profit foundation, run through the Catholic Community Foundation, invites donors to leave a lasting legacy of charitable giving to Mary, Queen of Peace. The foundation is restricted for service, separate from the Archdiocese's day-to-day operations, and protected.

In late summer 2025, a Steering Committee was formed to guide and implement the Hands of Grace. When the committee and Fr. Cooper launched the foundation on November 20 during a dinner for prospective Founding Angels, it became clear that Hands of Grace touched many hearts. The ecumenical foundation, committed to service and community outreach, shows the power of uniting our hands and hearts in faith and service.

There is still time for you to become a Founding Angel. The launch will close Ash Wednesday, Feb. 18, and has 3 levels of commitment: \$5,000 (Guardian Angels), \$10,000 (Cherubim), or \$20,000 or more (Seraphim).

A Generous Response from the Parish

The Hands of Grace has seen remarkable growth in both financial contributions and number of donors in just a few short weeks. Dozens of parishioners have stepped forward as Founding Angels, each contributing to the foundation's establishment. All Founding Angels will be recognized on a Hands of Grace plaque at MQP as well as on literature and the foundation website.

"We've been overwhelmed by the response from our parishioners," said Cherie Erkel, a representative of the Steering Committee. "It's clear that many believe in the service and community outreach ecumenical mission of the Hands of Grace and want to be part of something meaningful that will impact our community for years to come."

How you can become a Founding Angel

Checks are our most strongly preferred method for you to be a part of this effort. You should address the check payable to "CCF – Hands of Grace" and drop it off at the MQP Parish Center reception desk.

For all methods of paying, contact Mike Rohm at mwroh1@gmail.com or call him at (504) 250-4049. Other Steering Committee members are also available to help you.

In addition, credit cards are accepted, but they may include an additional cost of a 3% charge to the amount you are donating via credit card. For example, a \$10,000 donation may cost you an additional \$300. Consider, instead, avoiding that and write a check.

Transfers of funds, while possible, are not desirable.

As shown below, for our elderly parishioners on retirement who wish to leave a legacy of giving, the Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) and Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), are both excellent ways to both donate and reduce taxes.

The Benefits of Qualified Charitable Distributions (QCDs)

For individuals over the age of 70½, making a donation through a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from an IRA offers significant benefits. By directing the IRA administrator to send funds directly to the Hands of Grace Foundation, donors can support the parish's designated service and outreach initiatives while minimizing their tax burden. A QCD allows individuals to make a tax-free transfer of up to \$108,000 per year from their IRA to a qualified charity like the CCF Hands

We will tell the world that the Christ is born to save.

I am privileged to be your pastor, and I feel incredibly blessed and honored to be with you. I thank God for you, and I commend you to your true first Pastor, the Shepherd of our souls, the dear Savior, Jesus Christ. This Christmas, I want to again bow before Him with you,

happy and confident that in Him all things turn out for our good and His glory.

As we prepare to bid farewell to 2025 and embrace the unwritten pages of 2026, I am filled with an overwhelming sense of gratitude for the blessings that have graced our lives. REGISTERED ACTIVE & SUPPORTING AT MQP

We're glad you're interested in Mary, Queen of Peace Catholic School! We would like to remind you of the church support guidelines set by the Archdiocese of New Orleans.

Each student registered in a Catholic school is charged a Non-Parish Support Fee. If you are a Registered, Active, and Supporting parishioner, the parish pays this fee.

This means that you are:

- **Registered:** You are in our database as a registered, active parishioner.
- **Active:** You are involved in the life of the parish. This includes regular attendance at Sunday Mass.
- **Supporting:** Your contributions to the weekly offertory must be no less than **\$450 per family*** before December 31, 2025 to qualify you for the 2026-2027 school year. You must use Church Support Envelopes or pay electronically for this amount to be recorded. Online giving is available at www.maryqueenofpeace.org

A family should request a voucher for the Parish School Fee if Mary, Queen of Peace Catholic School does not have space in the grade in which applied.



Your Louisiana state tax dollars can provide scholarships to attend Catholic schools!



HOW IT WORKS:

Step 1: Make your donation to Aspiring Scholars by the end of the year.

Step 2: You will receive a 95% tax credit certificate by the end of January 2026.

of Grace. Since the funds are transferred directly to the nonprofit, they are excluded from taxable income, offering a valuable tax advantage. This strategy helps reduce the donor's taxable income while also benefiting the community.

Meeting Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) Another key advantage of QCDs is that they count toward the IRS's Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) once the donor reaches age 73. This means that donations made through QCDs can simultaneously fulfill RMD obligations, creating a "win-win" situation for both the donor and the community. "It's a fantastic opportunity for our parishioners," said Mike Rohm, Steering Committee member. "They're able to give back to the church and our outreach programs, while also reducing their tax liability. It's a great example of how our faith and finances can work together for the good of so many for years to come."
