
SATURDAY MORNING ROSARY MINISTRY

The Saturday Morning Rosary Ministry began many years ago with a small group from Mary, Queen of Peace making an early morning trip across the Causeway each Saturday. Squeezed into Jerry Broussard's car, they traveled to pray the Holy Rosary with Wilson Breaux, who took a bus from New Orleans to lead the Rosary at 6:00 a.m. outside an abortion clinic. Our group joined him weekly for several years, until the clinic closed.

When the clinic closed, the need for prayer had not ended. Recognizing that abortion remains a painful reality, the group brought the prayer vigil home to MQP, continuing the same spirit of prayer and witness on parish grounds.

Today, the ministry meets every Saturday at 6:00 a.m. in the church to pray the rosary together. This ministry is open to all who want to join in humble prayer, asking for the intercession of our Blessed Mother for an end to abortion and for a deeper respect for human life.

The Fishers of Men and the Knights of Columbus invite all MQP parishioners, along with family and friends, to commit to joining the Saturday Morning Rosary at least one Saturday each month. Participants are also encouraged to bring their own prayer intentions, trusting in the power of prayer to bring about real and lasting change. All are welcome.



JOY TO THE WORLD

Sunday December 21, the MQP Music Ministry brought joy to our parish through their beautiful music at a concert that featured the Adult Choir, Seraphim Singers, Handbell Choir, and Brass Quartet! The first concert at Mary, Queen of Peace since 2013 was joyful, festive, and reflective, allowing those present to enter into the mystery of God with us while also benefiting the Samaritan Center through free-will donations.

Performance highlights were "A Spiritual Christmas," "Carol of the Bells," "Night of Silence/Silent Night," "Dona Nobis Pacem," and "Joy to the World." Each choir has been working on their music since October, with weekly rehearsals and individual practice time spent outside of regular rehearsals. They truly sang with passion and dedication, inviting the listener into deeper contemplation and presence to the music that lifted our hearts to God's glory in Jesus. As the music ministry, our heartfelt intention is that our music and service brings you to deeper worship during prayer and Mass. May all of us—choir, cantor, musicians, congregation, and clergy—lift our hearts to God, making a joyful noise unto the Lord Who loves us.

WORSHIP AND GROW IN SPIRITUAL GIFTS



FROM THE PASTOR

The visit of the Magi is one of the most evocative scenes in the Nativity story, rich in symbolism and surprise. The “wise men,” or Magi, were likely astrologers or scholars from Persia, in the region of modern-day Iran. To Matthew’s Jewish readers, they would have been viewed with deep suspicion: foreign, pagan, and outside the covenant community. And yet, they are the ones who come seeking truth.

Their journey foreshadows the final commission Jesus gives at the end of Matthew’s Gospel: to go and make disciples of all nations. The arrival of these outsiders is a glimpse of the outreach of the good news. Jesus is a gift not confined to one people or place – he is sought by those who are hungry for truth, wherever they come from. He is, quite literally, the gift that keeps on giving. Herod stands in stark contrast to both Jesus and the Magi. Where they seek and worship, he plots and clings. Herod is paranoid and possessive, desperate to hold onto power. The Magi, meanwhile, kneel in reverence and open their treasure chests, willing to part with precious gifts in honor of one they recognize as greater. They seemed to know that earthly treasure is not to be held tightly. The Magi are true examples of living a life of stewardship.

Most people associate stewardship with giving. Some think it is a desperate plea by the church asking you to give time, talent and treasure to a worthy cause. Some think it is a noble gesture that

identifies a faithful steward, a common occurrence this time of year. And for some, it is an understanding that the stewardship way of life brings joy and blessings to the giver by returning a portion of the gifts he or she has received from God.

At Christmas, when it is most common to give or receive gifts, should this not also be a time when the stewardship way of life becomes the gift that is unwrapped by our consciousness and treasured by our faith? After all, the first gift of Christmas was the gift of God’s own Son. For those who may still be struggling to truly understand the stewardship way of life, that may be a concept that is difficult to accept, even at this time of year. But by living the stewardship way of life, it makes perfect sense to me. And during this season of faith, the gift of stewardship remains one of the blessings of my life as a Catholic, as a priest and as a pastor.

Before fully embracing a life of stewardship, I could justify wasting my time with less- than-worthwhile activities. I could rationalize withholding my talents, because I often thought somebody else would always step up and take care of things instead of me. I restricted or limited sharing my resources, thinking it wouldn’t make a difference — or worse yet, I thought others could afford to give more than me, because I believed I had already given enough. As each day passes, I remind myself often of how wrong I was in what I did with my time, talent and treasure. But the days for regretting my

misunderstanding of the stewardship way of life are over.

Stewardship conversion changes all of that, and the reverse is now true. The more time, talent and treasure that I can give, the more content and joyful I truly am. When is the last time you unwrapped a gift that gave you so much peace of mind and heart? Maybe you have never been aware of receiving such a gift, or maybe God is just waiting for you to unwrap what He has always wanted you to have. Perhaps it is the gift God wants you to have this year for Christmas.

The catalyst for stewardship is gratitude. And, as we recognize that all we have is a gift from God, it lights up our gratitude as if it were a large Christmas tree with too many lights on it to be counted. All we can do is look at it with wonder and awe, thankful for what we see, what we have, and the opportunity to give back something in gratitude. It is more than just a spirit of “holiday stewardship” that seems to be so common this time of year. It is the core of the stewardship way of life, and once that gift is unwrapped, our conversion takes hold and our lives are transformed into faithful stewardship intended by our God.

I hope and pray that you and your family will be blessed during this season of God’s grace, unwrapping the gift of stewardship in your lives and finding joy and peace. Like the Magi, may we offer the world Jesus – the gift that keeps on giving!
