On Saturday April 18th, our St. Dominic Pastorate Strategic Planning Committee gathered for an important step forward in shaping the future of our parish community.

Together, we prayed, reflected, and discussed a shared path rooted in our mission and guided by a clear vision for where God is calling us.

Our Vision

St. Dominic Pastorate is a growing Catholic community of faith that welcomes people to the living presence of Jesus Christ.

Our Mission

The St. Dominic Parish community will bring the love of Christ to all by emphasizing sacramental life, evangelizing, enhancing stewardship (Time, Talent, and Treasure), encouraging growth in individual prayer, and strengthening families through the education of youth and adults.

Through our work today, we identified five key priority areas that will guide our efforts:

- Forming people to have a living relationship with Jesus Christ
- Stewardship & Financial Sustainability
- Communication & Transparency
- Catholic School Success
- Facilities & Campus Strategy

Each of these areas include 2-3 concrete action items. Over the next three weeks we will be detailing these action steps in the weekly bulletin and through Flocknote.

Over the next year, our focus will be on **prioritizing and implementing these action items** in a thoughtful and faithful way.

These action items would not be possible without the parishioner input survey that was sent out in December. The Strategic Planning Team found those insights invaluable for the fruits of our time together.

We are grateful for the time, insight, and dedication of our committee members who were present today. In attendance were the three priests, the school principals, the Transition Team and St. Dominic Finance Council (which has representation from each parish)

Please continue to pray for this process—that the Holy Spirit guides our pastorate as we seek to grow in faith, unity, and mission.

Jesus said: "Amen, amen, I say to you, whoever does not enter a sheepfold through the gate but climbs over elsewhere is a thief and a robber. But whoever enters through the gate is the shepherd of the sheep. The gatekeeper opens it for him, and the sheep hear his voice, as the shepherd calls his own sheep by name and leads them out." [John 10:1-3](#)

The people of Jesus' time would have easily understood this story. It was common practice for shepherds to talk to their sheep throughout the day so that the sheep became familiar with the shepherd's voice as he led them through various pastures for grazing.

The first question for each of us to ask ourselves today is this: Do I know the voice of the Shepherd? Have I become so familiar with His voice that I can clearly distinguish His voice from others?

Reflect, today, upon the image of Christ the Good Shepherd, calling to us in a variety of ways. We must learn His true voice through faith and prayer.
