Dominic Deliberations

Thank you to everyone who have shared your kind words, condolences and prayers with me and my family as we grieve the loss of my mother. Your prayers, support, and affection have been very consoling for us.

IMPORTANT NEWS: Our pastorate 'St. Dominic' will begin the merger process on our Feast Day, August 8th. Merger means that a brand new entity is being formed, not simply that parish resources are being pooled together. This process contains many steps and the timeline of each parish's merger is affected by a number of factors. There are five stages in the merger process.

- 1. Pre-Merger:** We have been in this stage for three years and have accomplished a lot. Aligning our Mass schedule, staff, religious education, adult formation, bulletin, communication; to work together as a whole.
- 2. Canonical Merger:** We will no longer refer to ourselves as a pastorate but we will begin calling ourselves a parish. This stage begins August 8th, it consists of receiving a Canonical Decree from Bishop Hying establishing St. Dominic as a new parish with seven churches and three schools. Waiting 4-6 weeks between the reception of the decree and installing me as the 'Pastor'; my title up to this point has been 'Parochial Administrator'. The new parish of St. Dominic will elect a Treasure Trustee and a Secretary Trustee, these two will become the new trustees of the new parish entity, 'St. Dominic Parish'. We will send out bids to all banks and investment companies with whom we presently do business.
- 3. Civil Merger:** This stage, estimated to begin mid-September, consists of receiving new articles of incorporation, making us a new corporation in the State of Wisconsin, receiving a new federal tax ID number (EIN) and begin preparing for our financial merger.
- 4. Financial Merger:** This stage, estimated to begin in late November. It consists of choosing which local bank and investment company with whom we will do business as a parish and transfer our accounts to these local financial institutions. During this stage and not before, parishioners will be asked to make donations/write checks to the new parish, 'St. Dominic Parish'. We will have systems in place to insure that parishioner contributions will be applied for the use that is intended by the giver. New payroll, retirement, and benefit accounts will be setup and all previous parishes' assets merged. This stage is estimated to take 4-5 months.
- 5. Fully Merged:** We will be considered fully merged after we have completed all previous stages of merger: canonical, civil, and financial. Estimated time of completion of the merger will be April/ May.

We have made a lot changes already in preparation for the merger, so I don't expect there to be a lot of noticeable changes. There will be some changes like seeing St. Dominic Parish rather than pastorate, our churches will begin doing business as St. Dominic Parish rather than each individual church. Please join me in praying through St. Dominic's intercession for a smooth and successful merger. I would ask that you add this intention to your Saturday rosary each week.

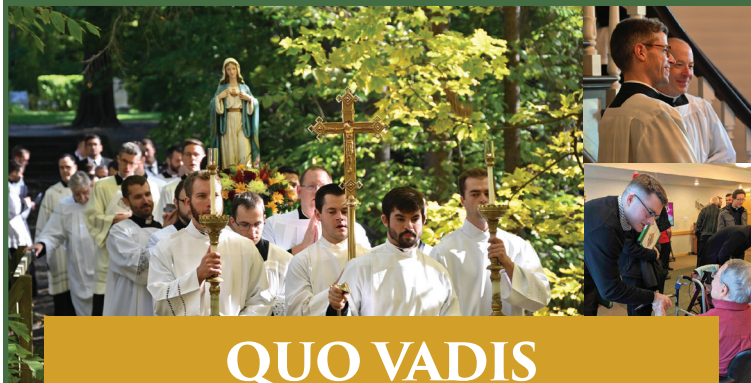

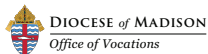
