

Dominic Deliberations

 \boldsymbol{J} n the gospel the 10 lepers are isolated from the public by the mosaic law and on a subjective level. They cried out to the Lord from a distance and Jesus healed them.

The month of October is Respect Life month, the Church highlights the dignity of human life from conception until natural death. While there are many issues that affect the dignity of human life; for example the dignity of immigrants, racism, sexism, homelessness, poverty, and respect for the elderly; the U.S. Bishops have stated, "The threat of abortion remains our preeminent priority because it directly attacks our most vulnerable and voiceless brothers and sisters and destroys more than a million lives per year in our country alone."

There are men and women who like invisible lepers walk around feeling isolated because of their abortion(s); wanting to be healed but don't know that the Lord has the desire and power to heal. They don't even cry out, 'Jesus, have mercy on us'; they suffer silently because the culture says that it's acceptable. The church doesn't only want to proclaim healing and redemption for those who are invisible lepers but she also wants to help those who have unwanted pregnancies carry this great responsibility. As responsible citizens we are called to help make adoption more accessible and abortion less available through our active participation in voting and asking our representatives to approve legislature that protects human life in the womb. Secondly, we are called to uphold the teachings of marriage and sexuality that promote a child's conception in the midst of a loving and committed sacramental marriage which helps protect against unwanted pregnancies. Thirdly, we have the privilege of helping those experiencing isolation to encounter the Mercy of Jesus Christ in the sacrament of confession and being accompanied at retreats like Rachel's Vineyard.

There are many other attacks against the dignity of human life that are becoming more common and socially acceptable in our culture that we are being called to not only oppose but rather propose an alternative that is upheld and promoted by the gospel. We do this by educating ourselves and getting involved in organizations that help promote these goods. Clarity Clinic, Knights of Columbus, Council of Catholic Women, Catholic Daughters, Pro-Life Wisconsin, and many other organizations are actively protecting and upholding human life. God bless,

Catholic Corner

"Ten were cleansed, were they not? Where are the other nine? Has none but this foreigner returned to give thanks to God?" Luke 17:17-18

These words were spoken by Jesus after He healed ten lepers and only one of them, a foreigner, returned to Jesus to thank Him. Ten were healed physically of their leprosy but only one received a much deeper healing. Upon returning to Jesus with a grateful heart, Jesus said to this one leper, "Stand up and go; your faith has saved you" (Luke 17:19).

Only this one leper, the one who returned with a grateful heart, heard our Lord speak these words: "Your faith has saved you." This reveals that gratitude to God is not only our duty, it also brings forth manifest blessings in our lives. When we sincerely offer thanks to God for all that He has done, we are manifesting great faith in God as a result. We are pointing to Him and His goodness as the source of our blessings and it takes faith to see this and to profess it.

What is it for which you need to grow in gratitude in your life? What is it that you may take for granted and have failed to properly return to God and thank Him for? The truth is that everything in life is a gift. Everything. Even the struggles you endure can be turned into blessings. In fact, that's exactly what happened in this story. The awful suffering of leprosy was turned into a grace from God.

Reflect, today, upon all that God has done for you. Pray that you will understand all of the countless ways that God graces your life. As you see them, ponder those blessings, count them and be grateful for them. And from that gratitude, return a joyful thanks to God. In that act, your faith will also save you.

Lord, I do thank You for the countless blessings that You have bestowed upon me throughout my life. I thank You for the ways in which You have graced me, led me and healed me. Help me to see clearly all that You have done and continue to do for me. As I see these blessings, help me to daily express my gratitude in faith. Jesus, I trust in You.


