Dear Friends, it is with a heart full of joy and anticipation that I stand before you, eager to begin serving you as one of your priests. My name is Father Joseph Bellamkonda, and I come to you from the Diocese of Warangal in India. I was born on October 25, 1983, and I am blessed to share that my parents are still alive and in good health. I also have an older sister and two wonderful nieces who hold a special place in my heart. My journey of faith and learning has unfolded entirely in India, from my early secular education to my seminary studies.

My own call to the priesthood took root in my childhood, while serving as an altar server. The sacredness of the altar and the holy vessels drew me in, sparking a deep sense of reverence. Following my tenth-grade education, I entered the seminary in Warangal. My theological studies then led me to the Regional Seminary in Hyderabad. After years of formation and discernment, I was ordained a priest on April 26, 2011, for the Diocese of Warangal.

For eleven years, I had the privilege of ministering in my home diocese, serving as a parochial vicar for two years, a pastor for five years, and for four years, I served as the principal of a school and a new mission. In 2022, a new chapter began as I came to the Diocese of Madison, where I was first appointed Parochial Vicar at Saint John the Baptist Church in Waunakee. Then, in 2023, I was transferred to the Christ the King Pastorate, serving the communities of Monroe, Belleville, and Argyle. And now, in 2025, God has brought me here to be with you!

I am truly excited to serve alongside Father Greg Ihm and to become a part of this community. I see this as a profound blessing and a great privilege – to minister in this incredible country and to walk with you on your faith journeys. Celebrating the Holy Mass and administering the sacraments are at the very heart of my priesthood, and I am also deeply passionate about evangelization and the corporal works of mercy. Beyond my priestly duties, I enjoy the enriching experiences of reading and traveling.

My deepest desire is to be with you, to serve you with all my heart, and to help each of you grow in your knowledge and discipleship of Jesus Christ. I eagerly look forward to meeting you, getting to know your stories, and building relationships within this community. Please know that I seek your prayers, and I assure you of my own as we embark on this new chapter together.

Join Catholic pilgrims from across the nation for a Eucharistic Pilgrimage event in Dubuque on May 23. All are


