Dominic Deliberations

Dear parishioners, many of you have heard that there's a new Christian Church opening in Kieler, across the street from Immaculate Conception. My initial reaction was shock, anger, and defensiveness and I've sensed others having similar reactions. These attitudes can lead to complaining about the situation, gossip, and destroying people's character; maybe in the hopes that the pressure is too high, and they'll move to another location.

I believe our posture shouldn't be a defensive posture but rather an offensive posture rooted in evangelization, catechesis, prayer, and seeking to strengthen our own faith in Jesus Christ present in and through the Catholic Church. When parishioners leave, it's because they haven't experienced Jesus Christ in and through His Church and it's our responsibility to change this. Jesus said, "if a man has a hundred sheep and one of them goes astray, will he not leave the ninety-nine in the hills and go in search of the stray?... In just the same way, it is not the will of your heavenly Father that one of these little ones be lost."

Beauty is what attracts, and the greatest beauty is love; Jesus is love. We should be able to explain the beauty of the Catholic Church in her creed, her work of sanctification through the sacraments, her becoming Christ-ian in each member by moral living, and her deep intimate communion with Jesus the bridegroom in prayer. These are the four sections of the Catechism of the Catholic Church; our lives and words should manifest these aspects of our faith in charity towards God and our neighbor.

When the community is shaken by a merger or another church coming to town, it is an opportunity for us to strengthen our faith and make sure that we are truly living as a community of faith. "They devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers. Awe came upon everyone, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. All who believed were together and had all things in common; they would sell their property and possessions and divide them among all according to each one's need. Every day they devoted themselves to meeting together in the temple area and to breaking bread in their homes. They ate their meals with exultation and sincerity of heart, praising God and enjoying favor with all the people. And every day the Lord added to their number those who were being saved." Acts 2:42-47

Catholic Corner

Queenship of Blessed Virgin Mary

On October 11, 1954, four years after proclaiming the Assumption, Pope Pius XII instituted the Memorial of the Queenship of Mary in his encyclical, *Ad Caeli Reginam* (The Queen of Heaven). This memorial was assigned to May 31, following the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, but in 1969, Pope Paul VI moved the date to August 22, eight days after the Solemnity of the Assumption. Largely this was done to create an octave of anticipation and to show that the Assumption results in the Mother of God being also the Queen Mother of Heaven and Earth.

As Queen, Mother Mary intercedes for us and acts as His mediator. From her heavenly throne, the Queen Mother of Heaven and Earth is entrusted with God's grace. Not the source, she is privileged to be the instrument of distribution. As a mother, she is pleased to lavish every good thing upon her earthly children. She longs to gather them together in Heaven, with and in her divine Son.

The heart of today's memorial is simple. We have a Queen Mother in Heaven. We turn to her with childlike faith and simplicity. As a young child runs to his mother in time of need, never questioning her love, protection, and care, so we run to her. She is our protectress, our refuge, our hope, and our sweet delight. Her affection is perfect and her motherly love unmatched.

Mother and Queen of Heaven, I run to you as a child with confidence and trust. You are the glorious Queen Mother, reigning over your children with love and mercy. Please pray for me and bestow upon me all that I need. I open my heart to your Son's grace that you are entrusted to dispense. Make me holy and free from sin, so you can present me spotless and pure to your beloved Son, the King of the Universe. Queen of Heaven, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You.
