# **Dominic Deliberations**

ctivities are picking up for the school year with committees meeting for the parishes and the schools. Please pray for all of our teachers, staff, and students that this year may be filled with Wisdom, Knowledge, and Understanding.

The end of year financial reports are being finalized and we'll share those with each parish when the reports are ready. Each parish finance committee will be meeting to finalize this year's budget and discuss where we are at. The Pastorate Finance Council will meet to continue working towards the merger which will include sending out bids to the banks and investment businesses. It will also be setting in place plans for aligning our resources to continue the great mission and difficult work of bringing the message of Jesus Christ to people who are in need of His saving work here in the pastorate.

We are reestablishing the pastoral committee for Dickeyville and Kieler, if you want to serve the church in this capacity please contact Lois or Tina. The other committees are meeting to discuss the local activities and needs of each location. An immediate need is for more sacristans and each church could use more lectors, servers, and Eucharistic Ministers. Eucharistic Ministers need to be trained before doing it, we don't have a date yet for that training but we will let you know when it is scheduled.

One of the goals of coming together as a pastorate is to try to utilize our facilities more effectively for the purpose of Evangelization. To this end I will begin working with a committee on the possibility of using the main floor of the Dickeyville rectory for multi purpose which includes: Parish Office, Dickeyville Grotto Store, Coffee Shop, and a meeting space for things like bible studies and social area after Sunday Mass. The upstairs apartment of the rectory will remain a residents area. In Hazel Green, I have discussed renting the lower level of the Rectory but we have decided to postpone that discussion until after the merger.

As a staff we have been discussing and working on job descriptions that fit the skills and talents of each of the parish secretaries. This would allow us to work better as a team rather than needing to be an expert in every aspect of parish life.

If you have any pastoral need please contact your church secretary or reach out to any one of our deacons or priests. We are happy to serve you as best we can.

## **Catholic Corner**

## **August 27: Saint Monica—Memorial**

Son, for my own part I have no further delight in any thing in this life. What I do here any longer, and why I am here, I know not, now that my hopes in this world are accomplished. There was one thing for which I desired to linger for a while in this life, that I might see you as a Catholic Christian before I died. My God has done this for me more abundantly, that I should now see you, despising earthly happiness, become His servant. ~Words of Saint Monica, from Saint Augustine's Confessions

Saint Monica was the mother of one of the Church's greatest saints: Saint Augustine. Raised in a Christian home, Monica became quite devout. She married Patricius (Patrick), a pagan, said to have had a violent temper and an immoral lifestyle. Patricius' mother, who had the same violent temperament, lived with the couple. Monica and Patricius had three children: sons Augustine and Navigius and a daughter whose name is unknown.

Early in her life, Monica had overcome addiction to alcohol. Her husband opposed her Christian faith and prayer life but also saw in her something that made him respect her. His refusal to grant her permission to baptize their children broke her heart. Monica's only recourse was prayer. She prayed fervently for her family's conversion, and her prayers began to take hold. Patricius was converted and baptized around 370, one year before he died. Patricius' mother also converted.

Saint Monica, you continually turned your difficulties over to God. You prayed, grew in virtue, and had a profound impact on your whole family. Please pray that I will never lose hope for those who have gone astray but will remain faithful in prayer for them, trusting in God's divine mercy. Saint Monica, pray for me. Jesus, I trust in You. 


