Dominic Deliberations

I used to watch storage wars, I found it fascinating. When you drive around, look and see how many storage facilities there are and then think back to a few generations ago. It seems that people have bigger houses, fewer children, and more stuff to store.

Pope Francis said, "avarice is the first step: it opens the door to vanity, to seeing oneself as important and powerful, and then to pride. And from there come all the vices, all of them. But the first step is avarice, the desire to accumulate riches. This is precisely where our daily struggle should be: learning how to administer the riches of the earth properly so that they lead to heaven and are converted into riches of heaven." This is the aim of the Christian virtue of poverty: "True poverty does not consist in not having, but in being detached: in voluntarily renouncing one's dominion over thing."

If the harvest is plentiful, why not store it up and enjoy it? Many Fathers of the Church have answered this question as St. Augustine did: "What is superfluous for the rich is necessary for the poor. One possesses what belongs to another when one possesses what is superfluous." The eagerness for human security spurs us to accumulate and store up goods "just in case," when in reality we often don't use them. They are goods that could be used by others, that is, by those suffering real needs and not only possible or imaginary ones. When those who are blessed with riches see in them a way to serve others, they learn to live poverty and detachment. It is only natural to want a certain degree of well-being and prosperity for one's own family, but we need to shun the foolishness of grounding our hope and happiness on material goods.

Catholic Corner

August 6: Transfiguration of the Lord - Feast

After six days Jesus took Peter, James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them; his face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light. And behold, Moses and Elijah appeared to them, conversing with him. Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah." While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud cast a shadow over them, then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."

~Matthew 17:1-5

All three of the Synoptic Gospels record the event of the Lord's Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1–8, Mark 9:2–8, Luke 9:28–36). Just prior to the Transfiguration, all three Gospels also record Jesus' trip with His disciples to Caesarea Philippi, located about thirty miles north of the Sea of Galilee. Caesarea Philippi was a primarily pagan Greek town occupied by the Romans. The Greek god Pan was worshiped there in a cave thought to be bottomless and often referred to as the gate to the netherworld because of its association with the pagan god. It was there that Jesus asked His disciples who they thought He was. Peter declared, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." Jesus then blessed Peter and announced His intent to build His Church upon Peter, declaring that "the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it..." (Matthew 16:16–18).

The Feast of the Transfiguration is strategically placed forty days before the Feast of the Triumph of the Cross. Thus, the Transfiguration should be seen as a preparation for both the Cross of Christ and our participation in that triumph. According to the Gospel, we are called to take up our crosses and follow Jesus for the glory of the Father, the fulfillment of His will, and the good of the Church, which will always prevail against the gates of hell.

As you celebrate the Transfiguration today, look at this event as a foretaste of the reward awaiting you, and a source of encouragement to endure all sufferings for the final victory of Christ. The Christian life, as stated by Jesus Himself, is about suffering and dying out of love and with unwavering hope. By uniting our trials with Christ's Cross, we share in His glorious victory for all eternity.

Prayer: My Transfigured Lord, You promise suffering and death to all who follow You, but You also promise the hope that awaits those who endure. Grant me the grace to endure every cross in life, uniting my sufferings with Yours, so that I may one day partake in the glory of eternal life in Heaven. Jesus, I trust in You. 




